



Ordinance # 51

State of Louisiana, Parish of Calcasieu, Village of Kinder

An Ordinance authorizing the taking of the census of the Village of Kinder, La, in order to have the same classified, and appointing Patrick E. Moore to take the census.

Sec. 1-Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kinder, that a true and correct census be taken of all the inhabitants residing within the corporate limits of the Village of Kinder be made, for the purpose of having the said Village classified.

Sec. 2-Be it further ordained, etc.,- that Patrick E. Moore be and he is hereby appointed and authorized to take said census and make a true return thereof to the council of said Village.

Sec. 3-Be it further ordained, etc.,-that this ordinance take effect from and after its passage.

More Excerpts from the Kinder Gazette

Kinder, LA February 23, 1911

Council Meeting

At the special meeting of the Village Council Tuesday night, P. E. Moore, census enumerator appointed at the last meeting, presented his certified report showing that he had found a population in excess of 1000 inside the village limits. This was found correct by the Mayor and Council, and the clerk was instructed to forward the same to Governor Sanders. This population entitles Kinder to advance to the "town class", and the Governor will doubtless issue his proclamation to that effect at an early date. This will entitle Kinder to five aldermen, and it is likely the necessary steps will have been taken to provide for their election at the municipal election in April.

A resolution was adopted directing that the necessary legal steps be taken to have the Frisco Railroad Company provide for the necessary drainage under their tracks on Eighth Street. The Council is to be commended most heartily for this action, as drainage is one of the essential factors in the health and sanitation of the town.

KINDER IS NOW A TOWN---was so proclaimed by Governor Sanders Monday

Mayor R. E. Oden on Tuesday morning received from Governor Sanders a copy of his proclamation issued the day previous, declaring Kinder advanced to the town class, entitling her to five aldermen. This was received very opportunely, as the additional aldermen will be elected at the regular municipal election, April next.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was attended by Mayor Oden, Aldermen McRill, Nevils, and Simpson, Clerk C. C. LaFleur, Attorney Odom, and a great many citizens.

From the Editor---Space did not permit printing the entire article---however these names were mentioned in the article: Messrs. J.J. Kingrey, D.T. Slocum, and T.T. Nixon, selected as commissioners of the election; A.N. Miller for clerk, and Marshall Davis as deputy of election.



The Octave & Evia Savant Oak
MEMBER, LOUISIANA LIVE OAK SOCIETY 1986

An Indian Village live oak tree has been admitted to the Live Oak Society, an organization of century-old live oak trees. The Octave and Evia Savant Oak is located two miles east of Indian Village, on that portion of the old Savant home place owned by the late Lorrie Savant Chatham.

This tree is 17.4 feet in circumference at the trunk, and a limbspread diameter of 106 feet. A minimum of 17 feet trunk circumference measured four feet from the ground, is required for member in the Live Oak Society.

This picture was taken with a 35mm camera by Charles "Billy" Reynolds. The oak is so immense the picture had to be taken in three parts and then pieced together so he could get a photo of the entire tree.

The only surviving Savant family members, who grew up under this tree, are Mrs. Nellie Reynolds of Kinder and Mrs. Odelia Lawrence of Austin. They each have camp houses near the old tree.

Buried: Indian Village Cemetery

One of the strangest letters is S which is actually a capital C. A misreading of it lead to a controversy as to whether John Durant's wife was Sarah Jooke or Sarah Tooke. Although the initial letter of her surname in the 1684 marriage record did resemble both J and T it was nonetheless C; her name was Sarah Cooke. Such misreading of records are obviously disastrous to research.

Other early letter forms included:

i = e k = h en = n fj = l

g = d f = i m = r v = u

d = ds p = i o = s q = u

g = e x = l t = t n = w

Certain letters were formerly used interchangeably: i and j, i and y, and u and v. Others could be easily confused: a and o, e and i, e and o, L and S, and m and n. Whole words like seventy and twenty were often look a likes. Numerals, too, resembled each other in certain forms, especially the 1 and the 7.


