These Terms and Conditions ("Agreement") govern the services provided by ABIONE Travel LLC ("we," "us," or "our") to our clients ("you" or "client"). By engaging our services, you agree to be bound by these terms. Please read them carefully before confirming any travel arrangements.

1. Scope of Services

- ABIONE Travel LLC provides personalized travel planning and concierge services, including but not limited to airfare, accommodations, ground transport, tours, travel insurance quotes, and itinerary coordination.

2. Client Responsibilities

- Provide accurate and complete information for all travelers.
- Review and confirm all booking details in a timely manner.
- Ensure that all travelers meet passport, visa, vaccination, and entry requirements for their destinations.

3. Payment and Fees

- Planning fees must be paid in full prior to the commencement of research or booking services.
- Additional supplier or third-party costs (e.g., airfare, hotels, tours) are payable per the vendor's terms.
- ABIONE Travel LLC does not hold or collect payments on behalf of vendors unless specifically authorized.

4. Changes and Cancellations

- All change or cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.
- Each vendor/supplier has its own change and cancellation policies. Fees and penalties may apply.
- ABIONE Travel LLC is not responsible for any fees resulting from cancellations or modifications.

5. Travel Insurance and Risk Acknowledgment

- We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance. Quotes are available upon request.
- Clients travel at their own risk. ABIONE Travel LLC is not liable for personal injury, loss, delays, or other disruptions caused by weather, pandemics, political unrest, or other unforeseen events.

6. Limitation of Liability

- ABIONE Travel LLC acts solely as an agent for travel suppliers. We are not responsible for the acts, errors, omissions, or failures of third parties.
- We are not liable for losses, injuries, or damages incurred as a result of travel arrangements, delays, or cancellations.

7. Force Majeure

- We shall not be held liable for delays or failure in performance due to events beyond our control, including but not limited to natural disasters, government actions, or strikes.

8. Dispute Resolution

- This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maryland.
- Any disputes shall be resolved through mediation or arbitration before resorting to litigation.

9. Privacy

- We collect and process personal information as outlined in our Privacy Policy. Your data is used solely for the purpose of delivering our travel services.

I understand that ABIONE TRAVEL LLC is not the source or supplier of the travel services I have requested, and acts solely as an agent for the actual suppliers of such services.

I have been advised that the suppliers whose names appear in the information supplied to me are those who are actually responsible for providing the travel services I have purchased.

I consent to and request the use of those suppliers and agree not to hold ABIONE TRAVEL LLC responsible should any of these suppliers:

- 1) fail to provide the travel services I have purchased;
- 2) fail to comply with any applicable law; or
- 3) engage in any negligent act or omission that causes me any sort of injury, damage, delay or inconvenience.

I accept that ABIONE TRAVEL LLC is not responsible for, nor will I attempt to hold it liable for, any injury, damage or loss I may suffer on account of any conditions, actions or omissions that are beyond its reasonable control. I will not hold it responsible for any injury, damage or loss I may suffer while on any third party provided or operated excursion or activity.

I will review my travel documents for accuracy upon receipt and understand that I may contact ABIONE TRAVEL LLC if I have any questions. I understand that discounted fares typically involve restrictions and that changing any aspect of my travel arrangements may result in the payment of additional money.

I have been advised to use a credit card as this may offer me the opportunity to dispute the charge should a vendor cease operating.

I understand that the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requires me to carry a government issued identification card in order to board a flight. I have been advised that the name, date of birth and gender that appears on the identification card must exactly match the same such data that is listed on my airline ticket and in my booking records. I acknowledge that my failure to strictly comply with these requirements may result in denied boarding or an undue delay at an airport security checkpoint causing me to miss my flight.

I understand that if traveling internationally, I must have a valid passport and depending upon my destination and nationality, I may need to obtain one or more visas.

I understand that the airline tickets, air tours or other products I am purchasing are subject to supplemental price increases that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Post-purchase price increases may be applied due to additional costs imposed by a supplier or government. I acknowledge that I may be charged additional sums by ABIONE TRAVEL LLC to offset increased fees, fuel surcharges, taxes, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination thereof. I hereby consent to any post-purchase price increases and authorize ABIONE TRAVEL LLC to charge my credit card for such additional amounts.
