- Make sure to have a negative Coggins for your horse upon entering the property. Those
 without a negative Coggins will be unable to show.
- You cannot participate in this event if you have not had a lesson on the Coyote Crossing Mountain Trail Course or a different IMTCA location. This is for the rider only, the horse used in the show does not have to have been used in that lesson.
- It is important that your horse wears some sort of leg protection to avoid injury on the obstacles.
- Helmets are required for riders under 18 years old. Riders older than 18 years do not have to use a helmet but we strongly suggest you do.
- You may enter as many classes as you like, but only first time competitors may compete in the Novice classes. You may only compete in two divisions though. Either Divisions 1 & 2 or 2 & 3.
- High Point award goes to the horse and rider team with the most points at the end of the series. All points from all classes will be added up to find the Champion.
- The day before the show (May 25th, June 28th, July 26th) is a practice day for competitors. If you are competing you can practice that day for \$40.
