



**Rider with Dog: March 21st, 2020**

When the pattern says the dog waits it means it waits at the obstacle while the horse does the obstacle. When the pattern says the dog follows, then the dog follows behind the horse over the obstacle.

1. Walk over the trestle bridge with the dog following.
2. Walk over the swinging bridge with the dog either following or waiting (choice of rider)
3. Walk onto the large box. Stand with all four feet on the box for at least 3 seconds. Have the dog wait.
4. Walk over the Texas two step with the dog either following or waiting (choice of rider)
5. Walk through the pond with the dog either following in the water or along the shore.
6. Walk over the rolling bridge with the dog waiting
7. Walk over the balance beam with the dog waiting
8. Walk over the teeter totter with the dog waiting
9. Walk up the steps with the dog following. At the top turn around and walk down the steps with the dog following
10. Walk over the little bridge with the dog following
