CASE SPOTLIGHT

United States v. Jones

24-cr-219

What's the Basis?: According to the factual basis, Jones and a co-defendant traveled to a New Orleans bar in a stolen vehicle. Once there, Jones met an individual and went into a bathroom stall. While they were in the stall, Jones' co-defendant entered, pointed a firearm at the individual, and demanded he get on his knees. The individual complied, at which time Jones and her co-defendant went through the individual's pockets and took his phone and wallet. Jones and her co-defendant were later found with the individual's driver's license, credit cards, and cell phone (which they had used to CashApp funds from the victim's account to their own account). Jones was charged with, and pled guilty to, a Misprison of a Felony (*i.e.*, concealing and failing to report the commission of a felony).

What's the Violation?: Millet pled guilty to **Misprison of a Felony**, in violation of **18 U.S.C. § 4**.

What's the Punishment?: The Honorable Jay C. Zainey sentenced Jones to **3 years of probation**.

Charge: Access Device Fraud
(18 U.S.C. § 1029(a)(2) and (c)(1)(A)(i))

Sentence: 5 years of probation.

Judge: Darrel J. Papillion
