**CASE SPOTLIGHT**

**United States v. Thompson**  
**25-cr-215**

**What's the Basis?:** According to the factual basis, agents with the DEA, ATF, and NOPD began investigating **Thompson** for suspected narcotics distribution activity. Investigators conducted surveillance over several weeks and ultimately executed a search warrant at Thompson's residence and vehicle. During the search, **law enforcement recovered multiple cell phones, a digital scale, marijuana, and methamphetamine.**

The search also resulted in the **recovery of a Kel Tec CP33 .22 caliber pistol, multiple magazines, and a significant quantity of ammunition, including .22 caliber and 5.7mm rounds.**

**What's the Violation?:** **Thompson** pled guilty to **Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine** in violation of **21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).**

**What's the Punishment?:** The Honorable Judge Jay C. Zainey sentenced **Thompson** to **24 months of imprisonment and 3 years of supervised release.**

**U.S. V. SANCHEZ-AMEZQUITA, 25-CR-087**

**Charge:** Distribution of Methamphetamine, Distribution of Fentanyl and Cocaine

(21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(A), (b)(1)(B) and 18:2)

**Sentence:** **70 months of imprisonment and 5 years of supervised release.**

**Judge:** Honorable Jane Triche Milazzo
