Day 1: Meet your ChmieBell Tour managers at the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport to handle your check in for our flight to Vancouver, British Columbia. **(PASSPORT REQUIRED)** A shuttle will be awaiting our arrival and transport us to our hotel for the evening to relax and enjoy dinner on your own.



Day 2: Set sail from Vancouver, Canada as we begin our 7-night adventure cruise.

Day 3: Continue cruising Alaska's Inside Passage.

Day 4: Arrive in Ketchikan and explore the city on your own or for an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board. Ketchikan is truly the beginning of the last frontier. Set at the southernmost entrance to Alaska's famed Inside Passage – a network of waterways that snake through some of the most jaw-dropping

and beautiful wilderness in the world. Ketchikan is best known for three things: feisty salmon, idyllic scenery and an incredibly rich Alaska Native culture.

Day 5: Arrive at Icy Strait Point, a small privately-owned cruise destination and village of Hoonah, Alaska. It is located on Chichagof Island and is named after the nearby Icy Strait. Check out the many additional excursions you can purchase on board or enjoy a strolling through the city and all the sites on your own.



Day 6: Arrive in Juneau for a full day of exploring on your own. Juneau is many things: the state capital, a mountain town, a coastal community and the most scenic capital city in the U.S. It is rich in history, art, music and Native heritage. It's an outdoor enthusiast's paradise, a shopper's trove and a food lover's dream. Or for an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board.



Day 7: Arrive in Skagway and explore the city that's famous for its hospitality, and offers all the amenities for a relaxing, adventurous and unforgettable time. It is filled with outstanding dining options, abundant shopping, entertainment and museums. For an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board.



Day 8: A great photo opportunity awaits as we cruise the amazing Hubbard Glacier this morning. The spectacular beauty of this natural phenomenon is breathtaking.

Day 9: Arrive in Seward where our cruising ends and our land tour begins. Enjoy a scenic drive in a deluxe motor coach to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center to visit the animals under expert care. Enjoy a stroll and lunch on your own during the stop in downtown

Anchorage, Alaska's largest city, before traveling further into the interior. After your tour and arrival in Talkeetna, take a stroll down the historic main street which reveals this funky town's singular mix of lively brew pubs, roadhouse restaurants, welcoming cafes, and unique local shops. Overnight at the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge which offers majestic views of the tallest peak in North America.



Day 10: Take in the mountain views on the drive to Denali. Experience the untamed beauty of Denali National Park on the Denali Natural History Tour, while scouting the tundra and forest for wildlife with a park ranger. After your tour, Denali is yours to explore. Hike the scenic trails that surround the lodge. Or book an optional excursion, like flightseeing or rafting on the Nenana River. Overnight at Denali Park Village embracing the natural beauty and rich history of Alaska and home to a marketplace designed to be reminiscent of a historic mining town complete with individually themed shops.

Day 11: The morning is open for optional excursions, with a guided wilderness hike and meeting the sled-racing dogs of the Husky Homestead among the possibilities. After a scenic motor coach ride to Talkeetna, you will board the glass-domed railcars of the Wilderness Express train providing a spectacular 360-degree view for the journey to Anchorage. This evening you can explore Anchorage and its vibrant city life on your own or enjoy a romantic dinner, visit a craft brewery, or stroll an urban trail in the evening sunlight. Overnight at the Anchorage Marriott.



Day 12: We head to the airport to catch our flight back to the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport with the most incredible memories to share with family and friends.
