
# Day 2 (Tuesday): Rockford, IL to North East, PA

The Hayes Museum was founded in 1916 by the Hayes family and State of Ohio which tells the story of the life and times of President and Lucy Hayes. # Day 3 (Wednesday): North East, PA to Portland, ME

### Day 4 (Thursday): Portland, ME

After breakfast we join our step on guide for a guided seaside city tour where we can enjoy the views and hear about the historic landmarks of Portland. See magnificent views of Casco Bay as we travel around the peninsula and see the boyhood home of the great American poet, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow where he was born and raised as well as the last standing maritime observatory on the east coast, the Portland

Observatory. We will visit the Portland Breakwater Lighthouse (aka Bug Light) for a photo opportunity and great view of the Portland skyline and the islands of Casco Bay. We will also explore the Portland Head Lighthouse,

first lit in 1791 and the most photographed lighthouse in America where you can get a close-up view of the glaciated rocky coast of Maine. An elegant tour of the Victoria Mansion will follow. A landmark distinguished for its architecture and its extraordinary original interiors and among the most important historic homes of the nineteenth century anywhere in the nation. This evening you will be treated to a harbor cruise and incredible lobster dinner! Included Meals: Breakfast, Dinner



### Day 5 (Friday): Portland, ME

Following breakfast, we will drive through the picturesque countryside to a guided tour of Pineland Farms. Located in the rolling hills of New



Gloucester, Pineland Farms is a 5,000-acre working farm, diverse business campus an educational recreational venue that welcomes visitors to enjoy its beautiful rural landscape. After our visit we will head to the Boothbay Railway Village featuring 28 historic structures where artifacts are displayed of rural Maine from the mid-19th through the mid-20<sup>th</sup> centuries. Take a ride aboard the Narrow-Gauge Steam Train and marvel at the antique auto exhibit with over 60 vehicles on display from 1902-1962. See the immense model railroad exhibit, authentic boxcars and much more. Tonight, get ready for the Carousel House Dinner Theatre Show! Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

# Day 6 (Saturday): Portland, ME

Today, we will embark on a guided tour of the charming coastal villages of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport. These town centers are separated by 5 miles and two rivers, but united by a common history and a laid-back seaside vibe. We begin by exploring the Franciscan Monastery,

established in 1947 with its beautiful English-style gardens, woodlands, outdoor chapels and shrines. View the beaches of Kennebunk while passing through the residential areas of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport. This road is lined with majestic Federal and Victorian style mansions that were the homes of sea captains in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries. See and hear the stories of the Wedding Cake House before passing through Dock Square and viewing the

beautiful Walker's Point residence of 41<sup>st</sup> President George H.W. and Barbara Bush. Next, we are off to the Seashore Trolley Museum where you can enjoy a trolley ride on an authentically restored streetcar through the Maine countryside. **Included Meals: Breakfast, Dinner**
