After our visit, we make our way through Missouri, and stop at the Gateway Arch, a 630-foot stainless steel structure that represents the spirit of the western pioneers. After our visit, we head to Kentucky for our next overnight and enjoy an (included) dinner.



**Day 3:** After our (included) breakfast we make our way to Tennessee and stop in historic downtown Nashville for lunch on your own. We continue our travels to Pigeon Forge, where we will check in and stay to unwind for the next four nights.

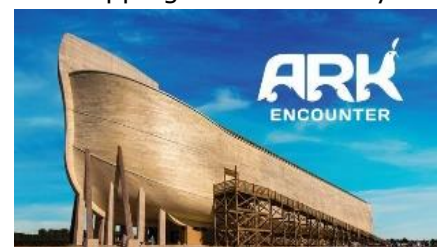
