It is known for its strategic location, historical significance, and stunning views of the Panama City skyline and the Canal itself.

Monday, January 19: - Panama Canal Full Transit Historic Locks (Arrive 6:00am / Depart 4:30pm)

The full transit of the Panama Canal is one of the most unique and historically significant journeys in the world, offering an incredible experience for travelers interested in engineering, global trade, and beautiful landscapes. The canal itself is one of the greatest engineering marvels of the 20th century, connecting the Atlantic Ocean (Caribbean Sea) to the Pacific Ocean, allowing ships to avoid the long and dangerous journey around the southern tip of South America.
