(Depart 4:00pm)

Our shuttle will be waiting for us to set sail from Vancouver, Canada as we begin our 7-night adventure cruise.

Continue cruising Alaska's Inside Passage.

Friday, July 17 - KETCHIKAN

(Arrive 6:00am / Depart 2:00pm)

Arrive in Ketchikan and explore the city on your own or for an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board. Ketchikan is truly the beginning of the last frontier. Set at the southernmost entrance to Alaska's famed Inside Passage – a network of waterways that snake through some of the most jaw-dropping and beautiful wilderness in the world. Ketchikan is best known for three things: feisty salmon, idyllic scenery and an incredibly rich Alaska Native culture.

Saturday, July 18 - JUNEAU

(Arrive 9:00am / Depart 9:00pm)

Arrive in Juneau for a full day of exploring on your own. Juneau is many things: the state capital, a mountain town, a coastal community and the most scenic capital city in the U.S. It is rich in history, art, music and Native heritage. It's an outdoor enthusiast's paradise, a shopper's trove and a food lover's dream. Or for an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board.

Sunday, July 19 - SKAGWAY

(Arrive 7:00am / Depart 8:30pm)

Arrive in Skagway and explore the city that's famous for its hospitality, and offers all the amenities for a relaxing, adventurous and unforgettable time. It is filled with outstanding dining options, abundant shopping, entertainment and museums. For an additional cost, you can add various excursions that can be purchased on board.

Monday, July 20 - HUBBARD GLACIER (SCENIC CRUISING)

(Arrive 3:00pm / Depart 8:00pm)

Hubbard Glacier is the largest tidewater glacier in North America. Unlike most glaciers, it's still growing and actively pushes into the sea. It's known for its towering ice face and dramatic calving (when chunks break off into the water) and offers breathtaking views of icy blue walls.

Tuesday, July 21 - COLLEGE FJORD (SCENIC CRUISING)

(Arrive 6:00pm / Depart 8:30pm)

College Fjord is a stunning glacier-filled inlet in Alaska's Prince William Sound. It's famous for having a collection of glaciers named after Ivy League schools, like Harvard and Yale. The fjord features over a dozen glaciers, including five tidewater ones, all nestled between dramatic mountains and lush forest.

Wednesday, July 22 - <u>ANCHORAGE (WHITTIER)</u> (Arrive 12:30am)

Arrive in Anchorage where our cruise ends, and our land tour begins. Step off the ship into a waiting railcar for our exclusive Direct-to-the-Wilderness rail service to the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge. Get settled and perhaps enjoy an optional afternoon excursion. The King Salmon Restaurant is the perfect place for a relaxed dinner to end your first day in the Denali area.

Thursday, July 23 - DENALI NATIONAL PARK & PRESERVE

Explore Denali National Park on a Natural History Tour watching for a glimpse of Denali and Denali's "Big Five", moose, bear, caribou, Dall sheep and wolves. Later today, you may want to simply relax with a glass of wine on the deck overlooking the Nenana River, visit the Grizzly Burger or grab a slice at Lynx Creek Pizza.


