In 1984, a group of interested women began communication with the Longview City Council about forming a commission for women. The Council was receptive, and in August 1984, Women in Longview was created. Women in Longview is a non-profit organization, that each Spring plans and produces Women in Longview Day. This event is designed to encourage, inform, support and motivate women. At this annual event, the organization awards scholarships to graduating seniors and adult women returning to college.

Women in Longview Day is made possible solely through sponsorships that underwrite the event, and scholarship donations. One hundred percent of scholarship donations go directly to scholarship recipients. Recipients are selected through an application process, wherein committee members dedicate hours to reviewing worthy applicants.

Individuals and organizations are invited to participate in Women in Longview Day, Thursday, March 19, 2026, at the Holiday Inn Infinity Center in Longview. This annual celebration of women provides opportunities to learn, network, shop, enjoy fellowship and be encouraged. The 2026 event will feature the delightful Kelly Swanson as its keynote speaker. Kelly is described as "a true pleasure, a riot, a lot fun and just a hoot".
