"Habemus Papam!" WE HAVE A NEW POPE!

POPE LEO XIV



Elected to the papacy on May 8, 2025, Leo XIV became the first American pope in history. He was born Robert Prevost in Chicago in 1955, served as a missionary in Peru, and was head of the Augustinian order from 2001 to 2013.

What about the name Leo?

In a tradition steeped in meaning, papal names aren't chosen lightly. They're carefully selected, often invoking the memory of past pontiffs and signaling the new pope's vision for his reign. And by invoking Leo, Prevost didn't just align himself with a name — he aligned himself with a legacy.

- The name Leo XIV carries deep historical significance in papal history as Leo
 is one of the most common papal names. One of the most famous is Leo the
 Great, who served as pope in the 5th century and famously convinced Attila
 the Hun to spare Rome.
- A new or long-unused name, like Leo, can hint at a fresh direction or a revival of an older papal legacy.
- Choosing the name Leo connects the new pope to a legacy of strong, influential figures in church history. Additionally, in Latin, Leo means lion, which is a symbol of strength, courage and leadership.
- The prayer to St. Michael originated with Pope Leo XIII in 1886. Pope Leo XIII composed the prayer after having a vision of the damage that Satan would do to the Church and the world in the 20th century. The vision occurred during the celebration of Mass, and some accounts say that the Pope fell to the floor as if he had died or suffered a stroke. The prayer is also associated with the feast of the Appearing of St. Michael on May 8.

Prayer For the Pope

O God, eternal Shepherd of the faithful, who tend Your Church in countless ways and rule over her in love, grant, we pray, that Leo, Your servant, whom You have set over Your people, may preside in the place of Christ over the flock whose shepherd he is, and be faithful as a teacher of doctrine, a Priest of sacred worship and as one who serves them by governing. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever



The Most Rev. Earl Boyea, Bishop of Lansing, hosts a weekly You Tube series called BMW...Be My Witnesses. It is based upon Acts 1:8 where Jesus said: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

The Bishop asks; "How do we do that?" He then goes on to describe a 4 step process as follows: Prayer, Learning, Belonging, Mission. Each lesson (typically no more than 4 or five minutes) is centered on one of these four pillars.

Does this sound familiar? Those of us in the Cursillo Movement have been living this since completing our weekends.

Notice the linkage:

Piety = Prayer Study = Learning Belonging = Small/Reunion Groups Mission = Apostolic Action

They say that imitation is the sincerest form of flattery. Bishop Boyea's study, which I highly recommend, can help all of us live Cursillo, and learn to better Make a Friend, Be a Friend and Bring that Friend to Christ.


