REUNION GROUPS ARE THE FRUIT OF CURSILLO

The real "fruit" of Cursillo is attending a weekend and the 4th Day lived through Reunion Grouping. This is the foundation of the Cursillo Movement in every Diocese. The number and strength of Reunion Groups is the surest measure of the health of the Movement.

To maintain and grow Cursillo we need to be laser focused on the vitality of our Reunion Groups, and growing relationships with others so we can invite them to "make a weekend." With these goals in mind, I request all members of our current Reunion Groups to focus on actions that can be taken towards them. Input from the Reunion Groups is encouraged. The following is a list created by the Secretariat:

- Each Reunion Group should compile a list of those people who were once in the Group, but are no longer Grouping. Then, one or more members of the Reunion Group can volunteer to call, have lunch with, etc. one or more former members of that Group to personally invite them back.
- Invite a former member of your Group or prospective weekend attendee/new cursillists to attend the Cursillo Mass on June 23 with Bishop Lohse, the Growler's Game on July 10 in Kalamazoo and/or the Cursillo picnic at Sacred Heart of Mary parish, Silver Creek/Dowagiac on August 4, 2024.
- Members of the Secretariat will be making the effort to go visit and Group with existing Groups.
- The Rectora/Rector of prior Weekends get their Team members to reach out to any new cursillistas who made their weekends that are not currently Grouping, and invite them to join a Group. In addition, Rectoras/Rectors of prior Weekends can create an email or text "mailing list" of all Team members and new cursillistas from that specific weekend, and use it to communicate information, prayer requests, etc. so as to "stay connected" with the camaraderie or vibe that was generated by the Holy Spirit during the weekend.
- Any other approach or method you might recommend (I am sure there will be several) to accomplish this purpose.
