Check the Entry Confirmation/Judging Program for the most current information regarding access times. Dogs must be removed from the show site by 8:00 pm Sunday.

TICKETS:

- 1. There is no admission charged to exhibitors for these shows.
- 2. Exhibitor's identification tickets will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank and should be received within a reasonable time prior to the show. Contact the Superintendent if tickets are not received to make sure you are entered. Superintendent can provide this information only to exhibitors who have utilized the exhibitor code provided on the entry form.
- 3. Tickets returned by the post office marked "undeliverable" will be held at the Superintendent's office.

FACILITY RULES:

- 1. It is a violation of state law to bring alcohol, illegal drugs & weapons onto the Arizona State Fairgrounds. Any person(s) violating the state law will be escorted off the premises by Fairgrounds security.
- 2. Smoking is not permitted in any of the buildings in accordance with state statute.
- 3. There will be NO vehicles allowed at any time in any of the show buildings.
- 4. Food and beverage stands will be available on the showgrounds.
- 5. No food sales by vendors or exhibitors allowed.
- 6. Water is available at this site.
- 7. No glass containers are allowed on the property.
- 8. Violations of rules & regulations or inappropriate behavior towards Arizona State Fairgrounds employees, Show Committee & officials or fellow exhibitors may subject any participant in this event to disciplinary action by the Show Committee.

CRATING, SETUPS & EXERCISE AREAS:

- Security will be provided. However, dogs, equipment or personal items left on the show grounds are the responsibility of each exhibitor. Neither the Superstition Kennel Club, Inc., any of the participating specialty clubs nor the Arizona State Fairgrounds is responsible for lost or stolen dogs or equipment.
- 2. Unreserved inside crating space is provided on a first come, first served basis. Roping off unused crating space is strictly prohibited & will be removed by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates & any other remedies it may deem necessary for consolidating space.
- 3. NO ELECTRICAL CORDS allowed in aisles.
- 4. Exercise pens allowed outdoors only. Pens must be set up on polyethylene sheeting if mats or carpet are not used. Sawdust or comparable absorbent material used to cover the sheeting must be disposed of along with the sheeting when vacating your setup space.
- 5. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up his (her) own setup area on a daily basis. Remember to bring a broom.
- 6. Grooming & crating space is available in all buildings & outdoors.
- Temporary crating of any breed at ringside is allowed only while that breed is being shown. This rule will be strictly enforced. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
- 8. Dog bathing facilities will be available on the show grounds. Only cold water will be available.
- 9. Dogs may not be left unattended in exercise pens or on grooming tables.
- 10. Dogs may be left overnight in the buildings.
- 11. Electricity is not available to unreserved setup spaces.
- 12. Generators may be used only outside the buildings in designated parking areas.

13. All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the show grounds, exept when in an exercise pen or obedience ring. Due to safety concerns, the use of retractable/flexi-leads on the show grounds is not permitted during show hours. All dogs must be on a lead not to exceed six (6) feet in length and under control at all times.

General Parking

- 1. All exhibitors should enter the Arizona State Fairgrounds at the gate located at 17th Ave & McDowell.
- 2. Day of Show parking is \$8.00 per day (Friday thru Sunday), per vehicle. Oversize vehicles (RV's, Box Vans) pay \$16.00 per day. If you need to leave the grounds for any reason, have your parking stub stamped at the gate for re-entry without charge. If your parking stub is not stamped, you will be charged for parking each time your vehicle comes through the gate.
- 3. Unlimited parking space is available.

(American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
