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2. Educational Plans

- College/Program you plan to attend (if known)
 - Intended major or area of study
 - Career goals
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3. Essay Requirement (One Page Maximum)

Prompt:

Please respond to the following in a one-page essay:

- Describe your experiences with inclusivity. This may include personal experiences, relationships, school environments, or community involvement related to individuals with disabilities.
 - How have these experiences shaped your perspective?
 - In what ways do you plan to promote inclusivity, accessibility, or empowerment in your future education, career, or community?
 - How can inclusive environments create a more positive future for all?
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4. Optional (but Encouraged)

- Letters of recommendation (1 maximum)
 - Description of extracurricular activities, volunteer work, or leadership roles related to inclusion or community support
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Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on:

- Thoughtfulness and authenticity of essay
- Demonstrated understanding of inclusivity and empowerment
- Commitment to making a positive impact
- Alignment with CSWS Foundation values

- Funds may be used for tuition, books, or educational expenses
