The Relay legs are different from the line events. The winning team is the team with the fastest 3 completed leg times added together.

Team members should enter as individuals on the Long, Medium or Short Relay course with the same Team name which needs to be unique, ie BAOC Kickers. Ad Hoc team are most welcome to enter and take part. Full teams can start any time if duty requires, however, maps will be collected from early teams starting. And teams are not allowed to view line course maps before the Mass start.
