<b>Travel Directions:</b>	Location: what3words: <b>arrival.dolls.powerful</b> From North turn left off A337 at Balmer Lawn, just before Brockenhurst, onto B3055, go under railway bridge and travel 2km and turn right into Campsite, park at GR SU3329702030; nearest postcode SO42 7QL. If coming from the South into Brockenhurst turn right immediately before railway crossing and then turn right to join B3055 going east for 1km.				
<b>Terrain:</b>	Area is mature forest plantation with a good path network, plus the open campsite area, there are a few small streams and some gradual contours. The longer courses (Brown & Blue only) will cross over the B3055 into the New Copse Inclosure.				
<b>Mapping:</b>	A4 size; scale 1:10000(1:7500 for SG/5000 for VSG); partial updates in 2024: map on waterproof paper; control descriptions on map & loose copies available in start lanes.
