Travel Directions:	Parking at Grid SU919462. Signed off the Suffield Lane, South West of Puttenham village; nearest post code GU3 1BE, W3W is: handed.ahead.conductor Map link here . Please note that the approach to Puttenham Common must be from the village of Puttenham (just off the Hog's Back) due to a road closure from the Seale/Elstead direction. There is no other access to the parking/assembly area other than via Puttenham (narrow road with some passing places).
Terrain:	The area is well contoured mixed open woodland/scattered trees with a good network of tracks and a wide variety of terrain. Courses cross a minor road into Britty Wood. Open heath areas are OOBs due to possibility of early ground nesting birds however, there are good route choice options.
Mapping:	A4+ map, Scale 10,000; 1:7500 for Short Green/VSG. Remapped by Tom Edelsten GO 2023, minor updates R Barrett BAOC Mar 25. Courses are over printed on waterproof paper with IOF descriptions on the map. Loose control descriptions will be provided at registration. Text description for the Long Orange courses only.
