Terrain:	Wooded with a few re-entrants and an extensive path network. Southern part of the map open plain with scattered plantations. Mostly runnable, lots of route choice. Full leg cover mandatory.				
Mapping:	A3 size; scale 1:10000 for longer courses. SG at 1:7500, VSG at 1:5000: map on waterproof paper; control descriptions on map & loose copies available in start lanes. Both SG & VSG start and finish on the northside of the road, all other course will have a road crossing and finish on the southern part of the map.
