John Mueller, from Google has a simple tip to help new sites get picked up faster.

If you don't have content on your site, you should keep your DNS disabled until you're ready for your site to be indexed.

Don't use generic server holding pages. These act like parked domains and will delay Google recognising your eventual site.

Instead of a generic holding page, use a custom one. This speeds up the indexing process. \leftarrow
