1.1. President's Report, Review/Approve Meeting Minutes

Presidents Corner:

*We have been searching for new board members for some time. Brian Long, Dale Fulkerson and Jovan Blackwell have shown interest in joining us on the board. Last week Matt Houtteman announced he would like to be on the ballot as well. In addition, per our bylaws, we will offer a position on the board to Amber Brown as one of our new National Delegates. Jim Kralik is ending his term on the board on December 31, 2024. He has announced that he will be stepping down in order to possibly relocate out of state. I will speak with Amber about joining the MSCA in 2025. Amber is very active on FACEBOOK. She would be a good choice to take over for Jim who monitored our FACEBOOK page for many years. I will draft up a MSCA interest form to send to all shooters as soon as possible. Anyone that wants to be on the board will send me a short Bio by Nov 15th. If we have more than 4 people that are interested in being on the board, we will send ballots out on the 16th. Voting will occur on-line by November 30th. Dan will assist with the election if necessary.

*Shot tracker continuing discussion. Charlie and Brooks have been writing up a resolution to be presented to the NSCA EC to disallow the use of electronic coaching aids at all Michigan registered shoots beginning January 1, 2025. This resolution was sent on 10/26 to the Assistant Director of NSCA Nicki Bowers to be presented to the Executive Council for consideration.

At a regular meeting held on September 18, 2024, the Board of the Michigan Sporting Clays Association discussed the matter of permitting the use of electronic shooting aids that provide information to the shooter such as, but not limited to, lead recommendations, target distance, prior shot orientation to the target, and/or target speed, at NSCA



registered shooting competitions within the state of Michigan. An example of this type of video recording/electronic shooting device is one known commercially as "ShotTracker" created by Take Aim Technologies. At the meeting, the benefits of this and similar devices for learning were acknowledged. These however, were outweighed by the degradation such devices cause to the confidence and trust shooters put in this sport's governing bodies to ensure a level playing field for all who participate.

Allowance of these devices erode actual and perceived fairness, requisite skill, and the competitive nature that predicates the legitimacy of our sport. Fairness is a prerequisite of competition, and the intention of this board is to preserve fairness to the extent possible.

Additional problems include possible continuous delays caused by its use and its inherent ability to give in-the-moment real-time coaching to competitors. The former is a violation of NSCA Rule VI. E. 3. (b) thereby disrupting the competition. The latter would be a violation of NSCA Rule VI. E. 5. if the rule is made applicable to all registered tournaments.

It is resolved and thereby recommended by the Michigan Sporting Clays Association that competitors shall not be permitted to use electronic shooting aids that provide information to the shooter such as, but not limited to, lead recommendations, target distance, prior shot orientation to the target, and/or target speed, while competing at NSCA-registered tournaments in the state of Michigan. In the event that a shooter is found using one of these devices at an NSCA registered shoot, all targets attempted with knowledge gained from said device shall be scored as lost.

*Matt will be hosting a three-day shoot in 2025 at the Hillsdale Halter Shooting Center. Matt has a number of sponsors that are financially supporting the shoot. The purse will be much larger than usual for our state. They are hoping to draw 250+ shooters including some Pro Squad shooters into our state to participate.
