## 1.1.1.2. Fundraising

\*Nearly \$2000 was raised at our gun raffle at the State Championship. The drawing took place and Kevin Radtke was the winner of the Fabarm Sporter semi-automatic shotgun generously donated by Pacific sporting Arms. Thanks to Jim, Matt, Brooks, Mary Jo and the DGC girls for selling the tickets.

\*Our next earplug sale will be held at the Great Lakes Tournament at Hillsdale on October 5-6. Clay Target Vision has donated a \$1300.00 gift certificate to purchase a set of Pilla glasses. We have the case and the certificate already in hand thanks to Greg.



\*Tickets will be \$10 each for one set of earplugs. With each set of earplugs purchased you will receive one ticket for the Pilla shooting glasses set. Only 130 sets of earplugs will be sold. When all of the ear plugs are sold, the winner will be drawn. Today I ordered more ear plugs for the sale.

#### 1.1.1.3. Liaison to SCTP

\*604 MISCTP shooters attended the 2024 State Championship at Mason this year. 306 shot the sporting clays event. Two shooters had scores of 91. Matt Gay set the sporting clays targets again this year.

\*Twelve scholarships were given away to 12 graduates ranging from \$1250-\$4000. \$33,800 in total was given away. Last year's total scholarship pot was a little over \$20,000. Loraine was able to find a number of new sponsors for this year.

\*A new grant of \$70,000 has already been received from Midway for further improvements. 2 more skeet fields will be built, and more traps will be purchased. An additional \$40,000 has already been donated to add 2 Helice fields.

## 1.1.1.4. Treasurer's Report

\*Checking account balance is \$28,409.41 which does not include the earplug sale money (\$1990) or the state shoot fees from Detroit Gun Club (\$2400). Approximate total \$32,799.41.

## 3.1.1. 2025 Michigan State Championship

\*Corrected bid was sent to all board members after our ZOOM meeting with Len Smith and Vince Lori on July 2nd.

\*Grand Blanc withdrew their Great Lakes bid for 2025 and put in a bid for the 2025 State Championship instead. They contacted Promatic to work out a deal so they will have enough traps to run a 200 bird main event. The entire State Championship will be completed in 3 days.

\*The new bid includes: a 100 bird preliminary event on Friday, a 200 bird main event on Saturday and Sunday, a 50 bird FITASC event, and a 50 bird 5-stand. All sporting events will be run with at least 16 stations with 2 rotations per day.

\*Box lunches will be available for purchase on Friday. Saturday and Sunday lunch will be included with the shoot fees.

\*The \$3000 MSCA enhancement fee could be used to pay for the main event trappers. I have agreed to help them locate trappers from their area. I am already looking at high school boy scout troops and dads in the Grand Blanc Area to fill the need. Vince said that we would need 16-20 each day. Grand Blanc can provide the extra trappers so only 16 would be needed. Brooks, I am hoping that you might help me with this task since this is your home club. There is a good training video on-line, but probably a one-day session might be needed to be sure that the trappers are all up to speed. This could be a good fundraising opportunity for the boys.

\*The date for the shoot will be June 20-22, 2025. We are trying to steer clear of shoots in the surrounding area. After doing some research: WI State Shoot July 9-14, Ohio State shoot July 31-Aug 3rd, Indiana state shoot Aug 14-17, US Open April 28-May 4, NC Regional August 6-10, NE Regional June 10-15, SE Regional October 1-5, SC Regional September 10-14, Western Regional August 27-31 and National Championship October 18-26.

\*After the negative FACEBOOK posts I have a couple of suggestions for next year's state shoot. 1. Offer Lewis class and Class purse for the main event only. We will get pushback from the club, but maybe we can convince them. 2. Snooker 3. Allow Dan to put together a sub-committee that reports to our board to find donations/sponsors/vendors to enhance our already great program for our State shoot and Great Lakes.
