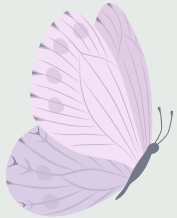

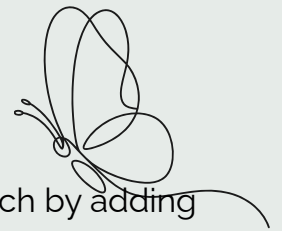

Dear Kendle's Krew Family,
2025 was a milestone year for Kendle's Krew! We proudly expanded our reach by adding a Hall County chapter and hosting two Crazy Kickball tournaments! Through these efforts, we welcomed 20 teams, 44 volunteers, awarded 9 grants totaling \$23,400 to special education departments and nonprofit organizations serving individuals with disabilities, We also introduced the Kendle Mae Scholarship fund providing \$3,000 in scholarships to four incredible siblings of individuals with disabilities.

Kendle's Krew also formed a volunteer partnership with the Toros Baseball team who served as "runners" between our umpires and tournament coordinator.

Even with our expansion, Kendle's Krew remains a 100% volunteer-run organization. We are deeply committed to making sure every dollar raised directly supports our mission. We are incredibly grateful to our volunteers, donors, participants, and advocates who help us make the world a little more accessible and inclusive for the special needs community.

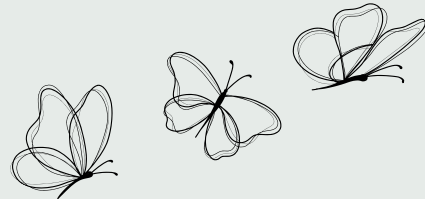

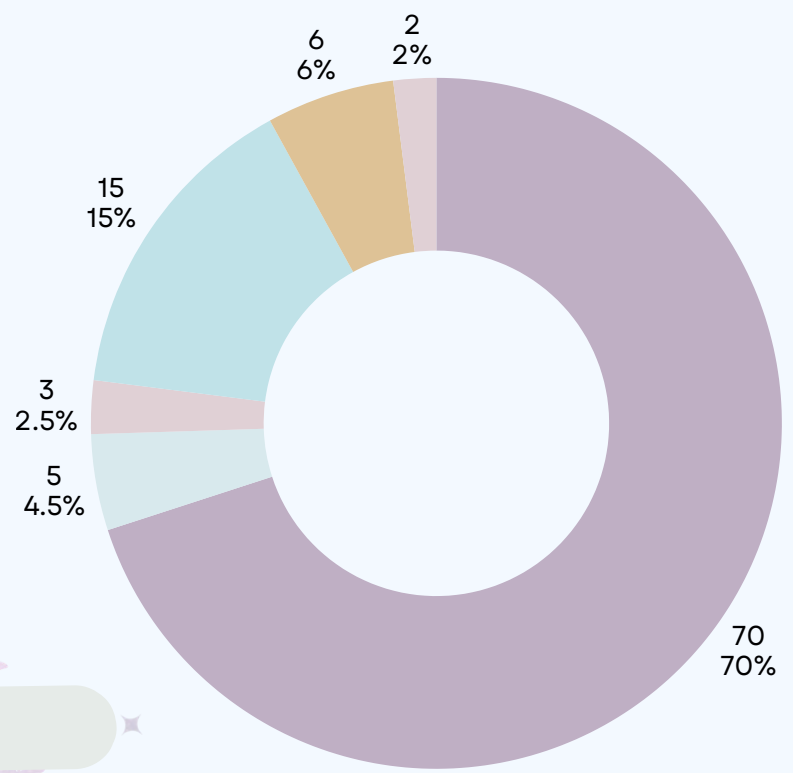

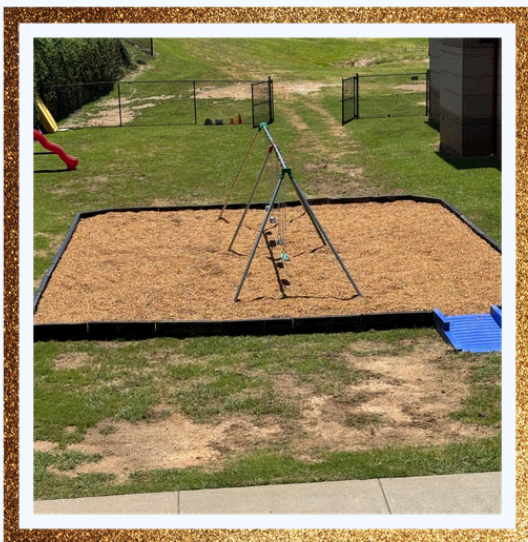


TAKING FLIGHT IN OUR COMMUNITY

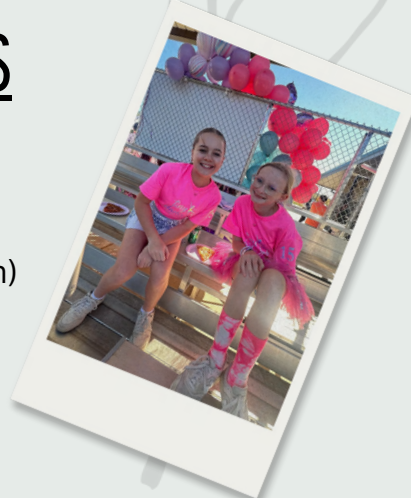
