



PANEX TRADERS – Export Documentation Information Sheet

APEDA RCMC

Mandatory registration for export of agricultural products like rice. Issued by APEDA via DGFT portal. Enables eligibility for export incentives and compliance with agricultural export norms.

FSSAI Central License

Mandatory for exporters of food products. Ensures compliance with food safety and hygiene standards under FSS Act, 2006.

IEC (Import Export Code)

Issued by DGFT. Mandatory for any import or export activity from India.

Phytosanitary Certificate

Issued by Plant Quarantine Department. Certifies that rice shipment is free from pests and diseases as per importing country requirements.

Fumigation Certificate

Issued by approved fumigation agencies. Confirms treatment against insects and pests before shipment.

Certificate of Origin

Issued by authorized bodies like Chambers of Commerce. Confirms Indian origin of goods for customs clearance abroad.

Commercial Invoice

Issued by exporter detailing buyer, product, HS code, price, and Incoterms.

Packing List

Provides packaging details including bag count, net weight, gross weight.

Bill of Lading / Airway Bill

Issued by shipping line/airline as proof of shipment.

Insurance Certificate

Required for CIF shipments to cover cargo risk.

Country-Specific Certificates

Some countries may require additional documents such as Halal Certificate, SGS/Intertek Inspection Certificate, or Non-GMO Certificate.
