• One Colour at a Time: Work with one colour at a time and fill in all the corresponding areas on the canvas.

- **Cover Small Sections**: Work in small sections to maintain focus and accuracy. Gradually peel back more of the film as you progress.
- **Regularly Clean the Tip**: Occasionally clean the tip of the applicator tool to remove any build-up of wax or gel, ensuring a clean pick-up every time.

Step 5: Finish the Artwork

- **Check for Gaps**: Once all the diamonds are in place, go over the canvas to ensure no gaps. Use the applicator tool to adjust any misaligned stones.
- **Seal the Canvas**: To permanently secure the diamonds, gently roll over the canvas with a rolling pin or similar tool. Some crafters also use a sealant spray to add an extra layer of protection.

Step 7: Display Your Artwork
