John Burmaster Memorial Student Scholarship

It is a tremendous honor that the WNYWWC offers the
John Burmaster Memorial Scholarship.

A Niagara Falls native John passed away on May 21, 2020, after a long illness.
This memorial scholarship is to remember the legacy he left behind.

About our friend John:

John was in the Naval Reserve and a long-time member of the Ransomville Volunteer Fire Department. He was Supervisor of the Town of Porter and Niagara County Civil Defense Director. He was on the Niagara County Water District Board, and later became Administrative Director of the District, where he retired in 1995. He was also a past president of the New York State American Water Works Association.

We have two \$500 scholarships available each year. Our preference is to award one to a high school student and one to a College/University Student. Awards will depend upon eligible entries each year.

Eligibility:

- ♦ Applicant must be currently enrolled as a full-time student, either a senior in high school or at an accredited college or university, majoring in any subject.
- ♦ Schooling related to the water or wastewater industry is preferred, but not required.
- ♦ Students applying to trade schools are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- ♦ Applicant must have an established relationship with a current WNYWWC member in good standing, that reference must be noted on the application.
- ♦ Student should demonstrate hard work, creativity, and initiative in their academic studies.
- ♦ Must be a New York State resident or attending school at an accredited NYS College or University.

Entry Requirements:

- ♦ Submit the following:
 - Application form on the opposite side of this page
 - Complete a one-page summary detailing any of the following applicable info; your course work, research, extracurriculars, volunteer work, future goals, interest in the water/wastewater industry. Anything that might be interesting to our review committee that would help you stand out in a crowd of applicants.

Winners will Receive: Lunch, an award presentation, and a \$500 check at the Annual Golf Outing on July 11, 2024.
