**\$75** - Instrument maintenance fee - for those using a school instrument - Cello, Bass, Harp. This money goes to the district and covers instrument repairs.

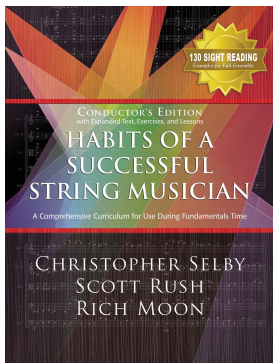

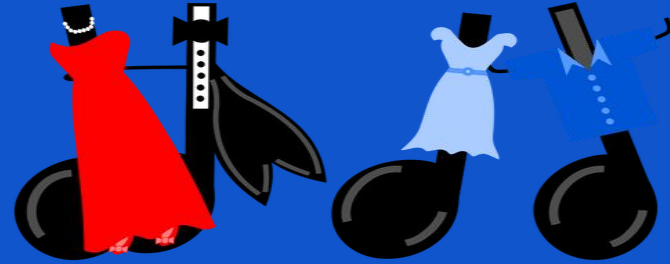
