Our meetings will include botany walks, roadside botany, field identification, nonnative invasive plant education, guest speakers, conservation efforts and outreach.

### **ALCHOLOISM**

High-Functioning Alcoholism Can Be Hard to Recognize. Here's What to Know You probably have a stereotypical image of someone who is an alcoholic. You might picture someone who drinks all the time, rarely has a day without a hangover and often can't recall what happened the night before. It's someone who can't get their drinking under control, even though their life may fall apart.

And yet alcoholism—more accurately called "alcohol use disorder"—falls along a spectrum that ranges from mild to severe. People with severe cases might look like the stereotypical alcoholic. But

with people who have mild or moderate alcohol use disorder, the signs might not be so obvious. They pay their bills, hold down good jobs and maintain relationships with family and friends.

"They may be quite skilled at hiding their alcohol use and not fit 'alcoholic' stereotypes," said Travis Chenoweth, a social worker at Banner Behavioral Health Hospital in Scottsdale, Arizona. They may acknowledge that they drink more alcohol than they should but deny that it's a problem. However, heavy drinking will almost always become a problem over time.

According to the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, heavy drinking is:

- More than four drinks on any day, or more than 14 drinks in a week for men
- More than three drinks on any day, or

more than seven drinks in a week for + women.

Here are some signs of alcoholism Alcoholics often hide their drinking. They may:

- Add alcohol to Gatorade or water bottles
- Stop at the liquor store when they pick up takeout food
- Drink before a social event, so their level of drinking there appears normal

They may also:

- Binge drink (typically, five or more drinks in about two hours for men, or four or more for women)
- Drink while at work
- **brink and drive**
- $\diamond~$  Have bloodshot, watery eyes or  $_{\rm M}$  shaky hands
- Minimize the seriousness of alcohol

#### use

- Avoid eating in restaurants that don't serve alcohol
- Have unexplained mood changes or are anxious or irritable
- Often, family members, friends and coworkers may notice signs like slurred speech, an unsteady gait or the lack of availability to participate in social activities in the evening, said Marcia Giannotti, a social worker/case manager at Banner Behavioral Health Hospital.


For people with mild or moderate alcohol use disorder, the signs may be more subtle. They may:

- Joke about alcohol use or alcoholism
- Need to drink so they can relax or feel confident
- Drink early in the day or when they are alone
- Plan not to drink too much but get drunk
- Deny drinking
- Be pulled over for driving while intoxicated (DWI)
- In many instances, a spouse or partner may use the phrase "high-functioning" to downplay the seriousness of the addiction.

Here's why high-functioning alcoholism is dangerous-

People with mild or moderate alcohol use disorder may perform poorly at work and put their jobs at risk. They may struggle to maintain good relationships with their partners, family members and friends. They are at risk of drinking and driving, using poor judgment with sexual partners and blacking out.

Over the long term, heavy drinking carries health risks. High-functioning alcoholics are more likely to develop some

types of cancer, high blood pressure, liver and pancreas problems and memory loss.

"High-functioning alcoholism' is an oxymoron," said Giannotti. "Alcohol is neurotoxic and inflammatory. It can damage your body in a multitude of ways, and in the long run, alcoholism can be

may be managing their jobs, finances and relationships, but alcohol use is still causing physical and emotional harm. If you or a loved one are struggling with excessive alcohol use, reach out to Banner Health for support.

Alcohol Use Disorder in Older Adults: Spot the Warning Signs "Dad has always enjoyed a drink after work. Now that he's retired, he's got a lot more time on his hands."

Unfortunately, it's not uncommon for advancing age and alcohol use disorder to walk hand-in-hand. It can be hard to see the symptoms in your loved one, and just as hard for them to see in themselves. The physical and mental decline that comes with aging can sometimes look like inebriation. So, how do you tell the difference? And if there is a problem, how do you bring it up?

Krista LaBruzzo, MD, an addiction medicine fellow at Banner - University Medical Center Phoenix, told us about how alcohol affects seniors differently than nonseniors, how to determine if there's a problem, and the misconceptions surrounding this important topic.

Alcohol and the aging body According to the National Institute of Health (NIH), drinking too much alcohol over a long time can have the following effects:

- ⇒ Increased risk for some types of cancer, liver damage, immune system disorders and brain damage.
- Worsened health conditions like osteoporosis, diabetes, high blood pressure, stroke, ulcers, memory loss and mood disorders.
- ⇒ Increased difficulty finding and treating medical problems related to the heart and blood vessels.



- ⇒ Increased forgetfulness and confusion, which can be mistaken for Alzheimer's disease.
- ⇒ Across all ages, alcohol can disrupt the immune system, which can cause more infection, organ damage and slower injury recovery. The older we get, our risk for these effects increases.

As we age, Dr. LaBruzzo explained, several things happen that directly change our alcohol metabolism. The first is that we begin having lower water volume. So when we drink alcohol, the alcohol's blood concentration increases, simply because the alcohol has less water to dilute it.

Second, aging livers have fewer enzymes to break down alcohol. And since our liver is the main organ for this task, our body's alcohol concentration is likely to be higher as we age, even with the same amount of alcohol.

"What this boils down to is that we are much more sensitive to the effects of alcohol than when we were younger," Dr. LaBruzzo summarized.

In her experience, the most common consequence of alcohol use/abuse in seniors is falls, which can cause painful bruises, breaks and fractures. The NIH estimates that in 60% of falls, alcohol is a factor.

Medicine, alcohol and aging: a tricky cocktail—

Whether they're prescription, over the counter or herbal, many medicines can be dangerous or deadly when mixed with alcohol. Some examples:

Aspirin with alcohol increases your risk of stomach or intestinal bleeding.

Alcohol used with large doses of acetaminophen (a common painkiller) can cause liver damage.

Some medicines, like cough syrups and laxatives, have high alcohol content. If you consume them while you drink alcohol, your alcohol level will increase. Using alcohol with some sleeping pills, pain pills or anxiety/anti-depression meds can be deadly.

Since older people often take more medications as they age, this risk can be quite serious. Dr. LaBruzzo mentioned the Beers Criteria, a list of potentially dangerous medications for older adults. Although the Beers Criteria isn't specific to the interaction of medication and alcohol, it's still important here because of how alcohol can intensify a medication's side effects. Regardless of age, it is always important to discuss potential medication interactions and side effects with you doctor or pharmacist.

#### How to bring it up—

Because symptoms of alcohol abuse can look so similar to symptoms common with aging, it's easy for the warning signs to go unrecognized. Dr. LaBruzzo estimated that 1-6% of older adults have an alcohol use disorder, and up to 30% of hospitalized elderly patients in a hospital's general medicine unit have an alcohol use disorder.

Older adults also face more social isolation and loneliness. In this state, they may self-medicate with alcohol.

"The biggest misconception is thinking it's rare for older adults to have an alcohol use disorder," Dr. LaBruzzo said. "It is common, and we should be asking more questions."

So how should we ask questions? Dr. LaBruzzo said the best approach is to simply be curious, and ask questions in a non-judgmental way. Your loved one likely doesn't see the problem or is more interested in denying it. A gentle approach will produce the best results when broaching the topic. The standard recommendation, she said, is for people 65 and older to drink no more than one standard drink per day or seven standard drinks per week.

Getting the help you need

### **TRIVIA ANSWERS**

1. Answer: Mensa is the largest and oldest high-IQ society in the world. It is a non-profit organisation open to people who score at the 98th percentile or higher on a standardised, supervised IQ or other approved intelligence test. The word mensa is Latin for "table" and is symbolised in the organization's logo, and was chosen to demonstrate the round-table nature of the organization; the coming together of equals. 2. Answer: When Burger King decided to expand its operations into Australia, it found that its business name was already trademarked by a food shop in Adelaide, South Australia. phe to form the new name "Hungry Jack's." On April 18, 1971, the first Burger King franchise in Australia was established under the new company name Hungry Jack's.

However, after the instrumental version was recorded, Knopfler considered the lyrics unsuitable to be sung by a male singer, so the track was dropped from the project. Mark **Knopfler not only gave Tina Turner the** song to record, but his Dire Straits bandmates were the backing band on the track. The song was released on Turner's fifth solo album, and reached number seven on the US Billboard Hot 100.
- 4. Answer: On October 1, 1924, future **President James Earl Carter was born** in Plains, Georgia. Jimmy Carter was born at the Lillian G. Carter Nursing Center, making him the first president to be born in a hospital. Jimmy Carter served as the 39th President of the United States from 1977 to 1981. Since leaving office, Carter has remained engaged in political and social projects. He was awarded the 2002 Nobel Peace Prize for work in finding peaceful solutions to international conflicts, advancing democracy and human rights, and promoting economic and social development.

Spider-Man 2, as well as episodes of Grey's Anatomy, The Simpsons, and Arrested Development. Andy Williams, Engelbert Humperdinck, Johnny Mathis, Perry Como, and The Four Tops have all covered the song.

- 6. Answer: Quartz is used by billions of people every day, but few realize it because the tiny crystals they use are hidden in their watches. If guartz crystals are subjected to mechanical stress, they can generate electricity. This ability to convert voltage to and from mechanical stress is called piezoelectricity. Inside of a watch is a tiny piece of quartz that is shaped like a miniature tuning fork. When an electric current is passed into the quartz tuning fork, it vibrates at a high frequency, more than 32,000 times per second. Watchmakers can translate this mechanical ticking into the ticks of a watch by using an electrical circuit.
- 7. Answer: Faith is the debut solo studio album by the English singer George Michael, released in 1987. The album spawned four number one singles on the Billboard Hot 100: "Faith", "Father Figure", "One More Try", and "Monkey", making George Michael the only British male solo artist to have four number one hits from one album on the Billboard Hot 100. Faith is one of the bestselling albums of all time having sold over 25 million copies worldwide. The album won several awards, including Album of the Year at the 31st Grammy Awards.
- 8. Answer: The story of Starbucks begins in 1971 along the cobblestone streets of Seattle's historic Pike Place Market. Starbucks opened its first store there, selling freshly roasted coffee beans, tea, and spices from around the world. can rock, R&B and soul singer and musician, best known as the co-founder and principal lead vocalist of Daryl Hall and John Oates (with guitarist and songwriter John Oates). Outside of his work in Hall & Oates, he has also released five solo albums, including the 1980 progressive rock collaboration with guitarist Robert Fripp titled Sacred Songs and the 1986 album Three Hearts in the Happy Ending Machine, which provided his best selling single, "Dreamtime", that peaked at number five on the Billboard Hot 100. He has also collaborated on numerous works by other artists, such as Fripp's 1979 release Exposure, and Dusty Springfield's 1995 album A Very Fine Love, which produced a UK Top 40 hit with "Wherever Would I Be". Since late 2007, he has hosted the streaming television series Live from Daryl's House, in which he performs

alongside other artists, doing a mix of songs from each's catalog. The show has been rebroadcast on a number of cable and satellite channels as well.

In the 1970s and early 1980s, Hall scored numerous Billboard chart hits and is regarded as one of the best soul singers of his generation. Fripp, who worked with Hall several times, has written, "Daryl's pipes were a wonder. I have never worked with a more able singer." He was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame in 2004 and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in April 2014.

**Early life and career** 

Hall was born in Pottstown, a Pennsylvania borough 40 miles (64 km) from Philadelphia, to a family of German descent. His parents each had a background in music; his father came from a Charlie Hall's

choral-group clan and his mother was a vocal coach. He started recording while still a student at Owen J. Roberts High School, from which he graduated in 1964. In college at Temple University in Philadelphia, he majored in music, while continuing to record, working with Kenny Gamble and Leon Huff as both an artist and a session musician. During his first semester at Temple, in the fall of 1965, he and four other Temple University students formed the vocal harmony group the Temptones.

They were popular additions to the largely black Philly soul scene, defeating both The Ambassadors and The Delfonics in a contest at the Uptown Theater. The Temptones recorded a handful of singles for Arctic Records, produced by Jimmy Bishop. as Smokey Robinson, The Temptations, and many other top soul singers of the 1960s.

In 1967, Hall met John Oates, who was also an undergraduate at Temple University. According to Daryl Hall, they met when "We got in the middle of a fight at a dance – I have no idea what the fight was about. I guess the Greek letters on one gang's jackets didn't appeal to the other gang. We both beat it out the back and met on the elevator while leaving the place rather quickly." Hall was by then a senior, while Oates was a freshman. They played together until Oates transferred to a different school at age 19. Hall did not let Oates' departure discourage him from pursuing his own musical career: he dropped out of college in 1968 and worked with Tim Moore in a short-lived rock band, Gulliver, and released an album on the Elektra Records label. He was a member of the studio group behind the project Electric Indian whose song "Keem-O-Sabe" became a big hit in 1969. In 1969 Hall again began recording songs by other artists, which led to the duo Hall & Oates signing their first record contract in early 1972. Daryl Hall and John Oates

**Daryl Hall and John Oates Signed** to Atlantic by Ahmet Ertegun and managed by Tommy Mottola in the early 1970s. Darvi Hall and John Oates have sold more albums than any other duo in music history. Their second album, Abandoned Luncheonette, produced by Arif Mardin and released in 1973, yielded the single "She's Gone", which went to No. 7 in the U.S. Top 10 on rerelease in 1976 after reaching No. 1 on the R&B charts when it was covered by Tavares. The duo recorded one more album with Atlantic, War Babies (produced by Todd Rundgren), before they were dropped and promptly signed to RCA. During their tenure at RCA the duo catapulted to international superstardom

From the mid-1970s to the mid-1980s, Daryl Hall and John Oates scored six U.S. No. 1 singles, including "Rich Girl" (also No. 1 R&B), "Kiss on My List", "Private Eyes", "I Can't Go for That (No Can Do)" (also No. 1 R&B), "Maneater" and "Out of Touch" from their six multiplatinum albums – Bigger Than Both of Us, Voices, Private Eyes, H2O, Rock 'n Soul Part 1 and Big Bam Boom – the last five of which were released consecutively. The era also produced an additional six U.S. Top 10 singles, "Sara Smile", "One on One", "Family Man," "You Make My Dreams," "Say It Isn't So" and "Method of Modern Love".

In 1972, Daryl Hall and John Oates opened for David Bowie, who was doing his first tour of the United States as his stage persona Ziggy Stardust. Of his relationship with the British star, Hall reminisced, "One time I ran into him in Jamaica...we went to the Playboy Club and got drunk while watching a bad reggae band!"

Later in 1985 the duo performed at the Philadelphia leg of the seminal Live Aid concert. After their set, the duo returned to the stage to back Mick Jagger and Tina Turner.

The duo released a Christmas album in October 2006 titled Home for Christmas. The duo were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2014. Solo projects



In addition to his work with Oates, Hall has made music as a solo artist, as well as recording with Robert Fripp in the late 1970s, working on Fripp's critically praised Exposure album from 1979. In 1977 Fripp produced and performed on Hall's debut solo album, the muchacclaimed Sacred Songs. This album was released in 1980.

In 1984 Hall co-wrote and produced, with Arthur Baker, the single "Swept Away" for Diana Ross, which reached US No. 19, US R & B No. 3 and US Dance/ Club Play No. 1.

In 1985 he performed two songs during the first Farm Aid concert in Champaign, Illinois. Hall participated in the We Are the World session as well as closing the Live Aid show in Philadelphia. He also made an album with Dave Stewart that year, Three Hearts in the Happy 2022 August 24

Ending Machine, which yielded his #5 solo single "Dreamtime". He has recorded such solo works as Soul Alone in 1993 and Can't Stop Dreaming in 1996, both of which were received well internationally. In 1994 composed "Gloryland" that was official album of the 1994 FIFA World Cup.

In 2007 Hall guest-starred on the HBO series Flight of the Conchords, playing an MC of a "world music" festival.

On March 12, 2008, Hall played a wellreceived set with his band at the South by Southwest festival in Austin, Texas. Hall was slated to sing the National Anthem of the United States before Game 5 of the 2008 World Series at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park but, due to an illness, could not appear, and Oates sang it instead. In 2009, Hall guest starred as himself on the Independent Film Channel series, Z-Rock.

In 2010 Hall was back in the studio working on a solo recording with bassist and musical director T-Bone Wolk. Wolk died of a heart attack on February 28, 2010, hours after completing a session with Hall. Hall released a statement about the death of his bassist of nearly 30 years: "It's not if I will go on, but how? T-Bone was one of the most sensitive and good human beings that I have ever known." **On June 11, 2010, Hall shared the stage** with electronic duo Chromeo for a special late night set at the Bonnaroo Music and Arts Festival. Their set consisted of a mix of both Hall & Oates:and Chromeo tracks. **On September 27, 2011, Hall released the** album Laughing Down Crying on Verve

UK Electronic duo Nero released their debut album Welcome Reality, which features guest vocals by Hall on the track "Reaching Out", which also samples Hall & Oates' 80's hit "Out of Touch". "Reaching Out" was released as the sixth single on December 6, 2011.

#### **Home restoration**

Hall restores and preserves historic homes in both the United States and England. In 2008, he purchased the 18th century Bray House, in Kittery Point, Maine and is in the process of restoring it. He also has restored a Georgianstyle home in London, England, first built in 1740, with direct waterfront access to the River Thames. He purchased two homes located near Hartford, Connecticut – one built in 1771, the other in 1780 – and had them moved to the same property in New York's Dutchess County where they were combined and restored. Live from Daryl's House Since 2007, Hall has hosted the online show/webcast Live from Daryl's House, which features live music acts in a podcast/videocast first from his home in Millerton, New York, and more recently from his club Daryl's House in Pawling, New York. The webcast has featured appearances by Ben Folds, Johnny Rzeznik, CeeLo Green, The O'Javs, Smokev Robinson, KT Tunstall, Joe Walsh, Rob Thomas, Todd Rundgren, Darius Rucker, Eric Hutchinson, Cheap **Trick, Aaron Neville, Chuck Proph**et, Travie McCoy, Ray Manzarek and Robbie Krieger of The Doors and many others, as well as a holiday special featuring Shelby Lynne and songs from the Hall and **Oates release Home for Christmas.** 

In a June 2008 interview with Blues & Soul magazine, Hall said of the webcast, "For me it was sort of an obvious thing. I've been touring my whole adult life really, and, you know, you can't be EVERYWHERE! Nor do I WANT to be everywhere at this point! I only like to spend so much time per year on the road. So I thought 'Why don't I just do something where anyone who wants to see me anywhere in the world CAN?! And, instead of doing the artist/ audience performance-type thing. I wanted to deconstruct it and make the audience more of a fly-on-the-wall kind of observer... I mean, what I've always done onstage is very natural. I talk to the audience and it's a very sittingroomy kind of thing. So I just thought I'd basically bring that to the web."

Hall hosted WGN America's 2010 New Year's Eve coverage as a Live from Daryl's House special. The special featured clips of previous episodes. Steve Dahl, a Chicago radio host, praised the special as the best New Year's Eve special on television for 2010–11, though he criticized the show's lack of a live countdown to midnight.


In July 2018, BMG partnered with Hall and Jonathan Wolfson to secure worldwide rights for Live from Daryl's House and will begin producing new segments beginning that fall, the company announced. The agreement includes worldwide rights to the complete run of 82 episodes filmed from 2007–2016, and the company is seeking distribution partners for the new episodes. Personal life

Hall was married to Bryna Lublin from 1969 to 1972. He converted to Lublin's religion, Judaism, in order to marry her. He has not actively participated in religion since, but has said that he feels more of a connection to Judaism than to his original affiliation, Methodism. While Hall admits to having had a passing interest in the ideas of English occultist, ceremonial magician, artist and writer Aleister Crowley, he does not consider Thelema to be his faith.

Hall had a nearly 30-year relationship with songwriter Sara Allen (the inspiration for the song "Sara Smile", and a frequent collaborator with Hall & Oates), which ended in 2001 for undisclosed reasons. They were never married. The two have remained friends, and Allen briefly appears in a May 2016 episode of Live from Daryl's House.

According to interviews with Hall in the VH1 Behind the Music documentary, the

death of Janna Allen, a close musical collaborator and Sara Allen's sister, affected him very deeply.

Hall had one biological child named Darren with Andrea Zabloski from Duluth, Minnesota. According to Hall, he and his son are not close.

Hall was married to Amanda Aspinall, daughter of British gambling mogul John Aspinall, from 2009 to 2015. Aspinall had two children from a previous relationship; her daughter March sang backing vocals on songs "Save Me", "Message to Ya" and "Eyes for You" on Hall's 2011 album, Laughing Down Crying. Amanda Aspinall died in January 2019.

Around age 60, Hall contracted Lyme disease.

- "Everytime You Go Away", written by Hall and featured on the Hall & Oates album Voices, reached No. 1 in the US and Canada in 1985 when covered by Paul Young.

The Daryl Hall and John Oates song "She's Gone", which Hall and Oates cowrote, reached No. 1 on the Billboard Hot Soul Singles chart when covered by Tavares in 1974.

Hall also sang lead vocals on, and wrote or co-wrote, nine more popular Billboard songs that also made it to the Top 10:

#### EMAIL SENT TO ME:

At the prodding of my friends I am writing this story. My name is Mildred Honor. I am a former elementary school music teacher from Des Moines, Iowa.

I have always supplemented my income by teaching piano lessons...Something I have done for over 30 years. During those years, I found that children have many levels of musical ability, and even though I have never had the prodigy, I have taught some very talented students. However, I have also had my share of what I call 'Musically Challenged Pupils.

One such Pupil being Robby. Robby was 11 years old when his mother, (a single mom) dropped him off for his first piano lesson.



I prefer that students (especially boys) begin at an earlier age, which I explained to Robby. But Robby said that it had always been his mother's dream to hear him play the piano, so I took him as a student.

At the end of each weekly lesson he would always say 'My Mom's going to hear me play someday.' But to me, it seemed hopeless, he just did not have any Inborn ability. I only knew his mother from a distance as she dropped Robby off or waited in her aged Car to pick him up. She always waved and smiled, but never dropped in.

Then one day Robby stopped coming for his Lessons. I thought about calling him, but assumed that because of his lack of ability he had decided to pursue something else. I was also glad that he had stopped coming. He was a Bad Advertisement for my teaching!

Several Weeks later I mailed a flyer recital to the students' homes. To my surprise, Robby (who had received a flyer) asked if he could be in the Recital. I told him that the recital was for current pupils and that because he had dropped out, he really did not qualify.

He told me that his mother had been sick and unable to take him to his piano lessons, but that he had been practicing. 'Please Miss Honor, I've just got to play he insisted. I don't know what led me to allow him to play in the recital - perhaps it was his insistence or maybe something inside of me saying that it would be all right.

The night of the recital came, and the high school gymnasium was packed with parents, relatives and friends. I put Robby

last in the program, just before I was to come up and thank all the students and play a finishing piece. I thought that any damage he might do would come at the end of the Program and I could always salvage his poor performance through my 'Curtain Closer'.

Well, the Recital went off without a Hitch, the students had been practicing and it showed. Then Robby came up on the stage. His clothes were wrinkled, and his hair looked as though he had run an eggbeater through it. 'Why wasn't he dressed up like the other students?' I thought. 'Why didn't his mother at least make him comb his hair for this special night?'

Robby pulled out the Piano bench, and I was surprised when he announced that he had chosen to play Mozart's Concerto No.21 in C Major. I was not prepared for what I heard next. His fingers were light on the keys, they even danced nimbly on



the ivories. He went from Pianissimo to Fortissimo, from Allegro to Virtuoso; his suspended chords that Mozart demands were magnificent! Never had I heard Mozart played so well by anyone his age.

After six and a half minutes, he ended in a Grand Crescendo, and everyone was on their feet in Wild Applause!!! Overcome and in Tears, I ran up on stage and put my arms around Robby in joy.

'I have never heard you Play like that Robby, how did you do it? Through the microphone Robby explained: 'Well, Miss Honor, Remember I told you that my mom was sick? Well, she actually had Cancer and passed away this morning. And well...she was born deaf, so tonight was the first time she had ever heard me play, and I wanted to make it special.' There wasn't a dry eye in the house that evening. As people from Social Services led Robby from the stage to be placed into Foster Care, I noticed that even their eyes were red and puffy. I thought to myself then how much richer my life had been for taking Robby as my pupil.

No, I have never had a Prodigy, but that night I became a Prodigy... of Robby. He was the teacher, and I was the pupil, for he had taught me the meaning of perseverance and love and believing in yourself, and may be even taking a chance on someone and you didn't know why.

Robby was killed years later in the senseless bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City in April,1995. A Footnote to the story. If you are thinking about forwarding this message, you are probably wondering which people on your address list aren't the 'appropriate' ones to receive this type of message. The person who sent this to you believes that we can all make a difference!!!

So many seemingly trivial interactions between two people present us with a choice. Do we act with compassion or do we pass up that opportunity.

You Now Have Two Choices: 1. Delete this OR 2. Forward it to the people you care about. You know the choice I made.
