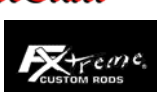

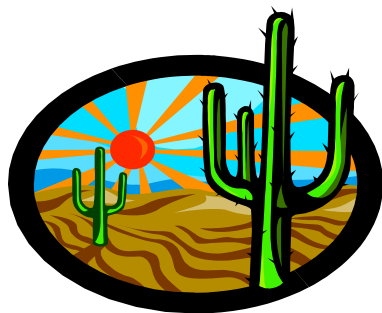

HOLLYWOOD WALK OF FAME



Martha Raye (born Margy Reed; August 27, 1916 – October 19, 1994), nicknamed The Big Mouth, was an American comic actress and singer who performed in movies, and later on television. She also acted in plays, including Broadway. She was honored in 1969 at the Academy Awards as the Jean Hersholt Humanitarian Award recipient for her volunteer efforts and services to the troops.


Early years-Raye's life as a singer and comedic performer began in very early childhood. She was born at St. James Hospital in Butte, Montana, as Margy Reed; despite her birth certificate showing Reed, some sources in the 1970s and 1980s gave her the surname O'Reed.

Her father, Peter F. Reed Jr., was an Irish immigrant; her mother, Maybelle Hazel (Hooper) Reed, was raised in Milwaukee and Montana. Her parents were performing in a local vaude-

ville theatre as Reed and Hooper when their daughter was born. Two days later, her mother was performing again. Martha first appeared in their act when she was three years old. She later performed with her brother Bud, and the children became so popular that their parents' act was renamed Margie and Bud.

Career-In the early 1930s, Raye was a band vocalist with the Paul Ash and Boris Morros orchestras. She made her first film appearance in 1934 in a band short titled *A Nite in the Nite Club*. In 1936, she was signed for comic roles by Paramount Pictures, and made her first picture for Paramount. Her first feature film was *Rhythm on the Range* with crooner Bing Crosby. She made her Broadway debut in the Harry Akst musical *Calling All Stars* in 1934, and later returned to Broadway in starring roles in *Yip Harburg's Hold On to Your Hats* (1941, as Marnie), *Jerry Herman's Hello, Dolly!* (1967, as Dolly), and *Vincent Youmans's No, No, Nanette* (1972, as Pauline).

From 1936–1939, she was a featured cast member in 39 episodes of Al Jolson's weekly CBS radio show, *The Lifebuoy Program*, also called *Cafe Trocadero*. In addition to comedy, Raye sang both solos and duets with Jolson. Over the next quarter century, she would appear with many of the leading comics of her day, including Joe E. Brown, Bob Hope, W. C. Fields, Abbott and Costello (in *Keep 'Em Flying*), Charlie Chaplin (in *Monsieur Verdoux*), and Jimmy Durante. She joined the USO in 1942, soon after the US entered World War II.

She was known for the size of her mouth, which was large in proportion to her face, earning her the nickname *The Big Mouth*. She later referred to this in a series of television commercials for Polident denture cleaner in the 1980s: "So take it from *The Big Mouth*: new Polident Green gets tough stains clean!" Her large mouth would relegate her motion picture work to supporting comic parts, and was often made up so it appeared even larger. In the Disney cartoon *Mother*

Goose Goes Hollywood, she is caricatured while dancing alongside Joe E. Brown, another actor known for a big mouth. In the Warner Bros. cartoon **The Woods Are Full of Cuckoos** (1937), she was caricatured as a jazzy scat-singing donkey named 'Moutha Bray'.

In 1968, she was awarded the Jean Hersholt Humanitarian Award in the form of an Oscar. After her death the statuette was displayed for many years in a specially constructed lighted niche at the Friars Club in Beverly Hills. On November 2, 1993, she was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Bill Clinton for her service to her country. The citation reads:

A talented performer whose career spans the better part of a century, Martha Raye has delighted audiences and uplifted spirits around the globe. She brought her tremendous comedic and musical skills to her work in film, stage, and television, helping to shape American entertainment. The great courage, kindness, and patriotism she showed in her many tours during World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War earned her the nickname 'Colonel Maggie'. The American people honor Martha Raye, a woman who has tirelessly used her gifts to benefit the lives of her fellow Americans.

Television career-She was a television star very early in its history. She starred in the short-lived (28 episodes) **The Martha Raye Show** (1954-1956), opposite retired middle-weight boxer Rocky Graziano, who played her boyfriend. (Raye was known to call Graziano "goombah", the Sicilian abbreviation of the Italian 'compàré' ('cumpari' in Southern Italian) - friend, comrade.) The writer and producer was future **The Phil Silvers Show** creator Nat Hiken.

Some of the guest stars on the show were **Zsa Zsa Gabor, Cesar Romero, and Broadway dancer Wayne Lamb**. She also appeared on

other TV shows in the 1950s, such as What's My Line?

Following the demise of her TV variety show, the breakup of her fifth marriage, and a series of other personal and health problems, she attempted suicide by overdosing on sleeping pills on August 14, 1956. Well-wishers gave her a St. Christopher's medal, a St. Genesius medal, and a Star of David. After her recovery, she wore these amulets faithfully, although she was neither Catholic nor Jewish. At the conclusion of each episode of her TV shows, she would thank the nuns at the Sisters of St. Francis Hospital in Miami, Florida, where she had recovered. She always said "Goodnight, Sisters" as a sign of appreciation and gratitude.

Later in her career, she made television commercials for Polident denture cleanser, principally during the 1970s and 1980s.

In 1970, she portrayed Boss Witch, the "Queen of all Witchdom", in the feature film Pufnstuf for Sid and Marty Krofft. This led to her being cast as villainess Benita Bizarre in The Bugaloos (1970), which the Kroffts produced the same year.

She often appeared as a guest on other programs, particularly those which often featured older performers as guest stars, such as ABC's The Love Boat, and also on variety programs, including the short-lived The Roy Rogers and Dale Evans Show. She appeared from the third to the ninth seasons as Carrie Sharples, Mel's mother on Alice, making two or three appearances a season. She made guest appearances or did cameo roles in such series as Murder, She Wrote on CBS and The Andy Williams Show and McMillan & Wife, both on NBC. She appeared again as Agatha for the six-episode run of the retooled McMillan, taking over for Nancy Walker, who had left the series. Her last film appearance was as an incontinent airline passenger in

the disaster film *The Concorde ... Airport '79* (1979).

Personal life-Raye's personal life was complex and emotionally tumultuous. She was married seven times.

Raye was a devout Methodist. She regularly attended church, read the Bible daily, and taught Sunday school. Because her religious views were often misconstrued, she said, "One paper says I'm Catholic and the other says I'm Jewish. I guess that's fitting because, as a Methodist, I'm meant to be undertermined some of the time".

Her engagement to orchestra leader Johnny Torrence was announced in June 1936. Less than two months later she commented, "They tell me I've gone Hollywood already because I got engaged to Johnny Torrence one day and broke it off the next."

She was married to make-up artist Hamilton "Buddy" Westmore from May 30, 1937, until September 1937, filing for divorce on the basis of extreme cruelty; to composer-conductor David Rose from October 8, 1938, to May 19, 1941; to Neal Lang from May 25, 1941, to February 3, 1944; to Nick Condos from February 22, 1944, to June 17, 1953; to Edward T. Begley from April 21, 1954, to October 6, 1956; to Robert O'Shea from November 7, 1956, to December 1, 1960; and to Mark Harris from September 25, 1991, until her death in 1994. She had one child, a daughter, Melodye Condos (born July 26, 1944), with her fourth husband, Nick Condos.

Politically, Raye was conservative, affirming her political views by informing an interviewer in 1984, "I believe in the constitution, strength in national defense, limited government, individual freedom, and personal responsibility. They reinforce the resolve the United States is the greatest country in the world and we can all be eternally grateful to our founding fathers for the beautiful legacy they left us."

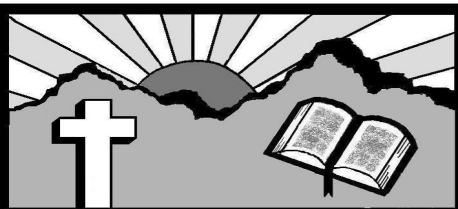

Death-Ray's final years were plagued by ill health. She had a history of cardiovascular disease and suffered from Alzheimer's disease, in addition to losing both legs in 1993 due to poor circulation. While resting in the hospital-type bed in her home, she and her husband Mark Harris (who, because of their controversial May/December relationship, became a frequent guest on the popular Howard Stern radio program) were forced to move into a hotel after their house was destroyed in the 1994 Northridge earthquake. Raye died at age 78 of pneumonia on October 19, 1994.

Appreciation of her work with the USO during World War II and subsequent wars led to her being named both an honorary colonel in the U.S. Marines and an honorary lieutenant colonel in the U.S. Army, and earned special consideration to be buried in Arlington National Cemetery. Upon her death it was instead requested that she be buried with full military honors in the Fort Bragg Main Post cemetery at Spring Lake, North Carolina, home of her loving and beloved United States Army Special Forces; the Fifth Special Forces Group (Airborne) made her an honorary Green Beret for her USO work in Vietnam.

Raye has two stars on the Hollywood Walk of Fame—one for motion pictures at 6251 Hollywood Boulevard and the other for television at 6547 Hollywood Blvd.

Archive-The moving image collection of Martha Raye is held at the Academy Film Archive. The collection consists of an audio tape and home movies.

HOLLYWOOD WALK OF FAME



Louis Allen Rawls (December 1, 1933 – January 6, 2006) was an American record producer, singer, composer and actor. Rawls released more than 60 albums, sold more than 40 million records, and had numerous charting sin-

gles, most notably his song "You'll Never Find Another Love like Mine". He worked as a film, television, and voice actor. He was also a three-time Grammy-winner, all for Best Male R&B Vocal Performance.

Early life-Rawls was born in Chicago on December 1, 1933, and raised by his grandmother in the Ida B. Wells projects on the city's South Side. He began singing in the Greater Mount Olive Baptist Church choir at the age of seven and later sang with local groups through which he met Sam Cooke, who was nearly three years older, and Curtis Mayfield.

Career-After graduating from Dunbar Vocational High School, he sang briefly with Cooke in the Teenage Kings of Harmony, a gospel group, and then with the Holy Wonders. In 1951, he replaced Cooke in the Highway QC's after Cooke departed to join The Soul Stirrers in Los Angeles. Rawls was hired by the Chosen Gospel Singers and moved to Los Angeles, where he joined the Pilgrim Travelers.

In 1955, Rawls enlisted in the United States Army as a paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division. He served in B Co 2/505th Parachute Infantry and made 26 jumps. He left the Army three years later as a Sergeant and rejoined the Pilgrim Travelers (then known as the Travelers). In 1958, while touring the South with the Travelers and Sam Cooke, Rawls was in a car crash. He was pronounced dead before arriving at the hospital, where he stayed in a coma for five and a half days. He spent a year recuperating and it was several months before his memory returned. He considered the crash a life-changing event.

With Dick Clark as master of ceremonies, Rawls was able to perform at the Hollywood Bowl in 1959. His first two singles were "Love, Love, Love" and "Walkin' (For Miles)" for Shar-Dee Records, a label owned by Herb Alpert. "In My Little Black Book" and "80 Ways" were released a year later by Candix Records. In 1962 he signed a contract with Capitol Records and sang backing vocals on "Bring It On Home to Me" and "That's Where

It's At", both written by Cooke. Rawls charted with a cover of "Bring It On Home to Me" in 1970 (with the title shortened to "Bring It On Home").

Soul is truth...no matter where it comes from, no matter how it is presented

Stormy Monday, a jazz album with Les McCann, was released in 1962. The next two Capitol albums (Black and Blue, Tobacco Road) sold well and employed Onzy Matthews as musical director and a 17-piece big band. Both albums reached the Billboard magazine charts and propelled his career.

Although his 1966 album Live! was certified gold, Rawls would not have a star-making hit until he made a soul album, named Soulin' , later that year. The album contained "Love Is a Hurtin' Thing", his first R&B No.1 single. In 1967, he won a Grammy Award for Best R&B Vocal Performance for the single "Dead End Street". In 1967, he performed at the first

evening of the Monterey International Pop Music Festival.

In 1969, Rawls was co-host of NBC's summer replacement series for the Dean Martin Show with Martin's daughter, singer Gail Martin. After leaving Capitol in 1971, he signed with MGM and released the single "Natural Man" written for him by comedian Sandy Baron and singer Bobby Hebb. For Bell Records in 1974 he recorded a cover version of "She's Gone" by Hall & Oates. Two years later with his new manager Martin Pichinson, he signed with Philadelphia International and recorded All Things in Time, which sold a million copies. "You'll Never Find Another Love Like Mine" became his biggest selling single, selling a million copies, topping the R&B and Adult Contemporary charts, and reaching No. 2 on the pop chart. The hit single "Lady Love" followed, from the 1977 album When You Hear Lou, You've Heard It All.

Charity-In 1980, Rawls began the Lou Rawls Parade of Stars Telethon which benefits the

United Negro College Fund. The annual event, known since 1998 as "An Evening of Stars: A Celebration of Educational Excellence", consists of stories of successful black students who have benefited from and/or graduated from one of the many historically black colleges and universities who receive support from the UNCF, along with musical performances from various recording artists in support of the UNCF's and Rawls' efforts. The event raised over US\$250 million for the fund at the time of Rawls' death in 2006.

Television and film-Rawls appeared in a segment aired during the first season of Sesame Street to sing the alphabet. He dismissed the suggestion to use cue cards for the performance but reversed his decision when he forgot the order of the letters. He was a guest during the second season of The Muppet Show.

His first acting credit was in the Western television series The Big Valley (starring Barbara Stanwyck, along with Lee Majors and Linda Evans). He was also in the season 5 episode "Lifeline" of the television show Mannix and the season 6 episode "Return to the Cotton Club" of the show Fantasy Island. He appeared in the films Leaving Las Vegas, Blues Brothers 2000, and Angel, Angel, Down We Go. He had a role and sang in Lookin' Italian (1994), an independent film about the mafia. He had a supporting role in Baywatch Nights. He was a guest host on Jazz Central, a television program that was broadcast on the BET channel.

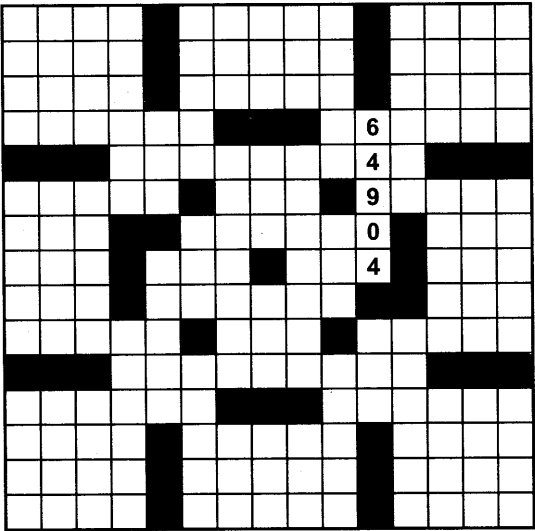
For many years, he was a spokesperson for the Colonial Penn Life Insurance Company. First appearing in television and radio commercials in the mid-to-late 1960s for Spur Malt Liquor, a Rainier Brewing Company product in Seattle. He appeared in a number of Budweiser advertisements. Budweiser was a sponsor for the Rawls telethon and UNCF. There was no attempt to avoid the similarity between the title of the 1977 album When You've Heard Lou, You've Heard It All and his

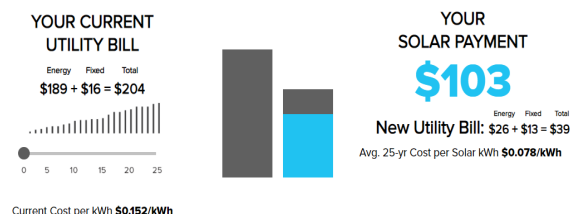

corporate sponsor's slogan "When You Say Bud, You've Said It All". A track on the 1978 album Lou Rawls Live features him singing the commercial slogan. Anheuser-Busch, the brewers of Budweiser, suggested his telethon work to him.

Rawls lent his rich baritone to cartoons, including Hey Arnold!, Garfield, Captain Planet and the Planeteers and The Proud Family. For many of the Film Roman Garfield specials, Rawls would often compose songs, which he would then sing usually doing a duet with Desiree Goyette, as well as the singing voice of the title character himself.

In the season 2 episode of My Wife and Kids entitled "Michael's Garden", Lou Rawls himself sings "You'll Never Find Another Love Like Mine" to Michael Kyle (Damon Wayans) during a colonoscopy.

Personal life-Rawls was married three times. His third wife, Nina, a former flight at-

tendant, managed his career during his last two years. They had one son, Aiden Rawls. Rawls was also survived by another son, Lou Rawls Jr.; two daughters, Louanna Rawls of Los Angeles and Kendra Smith of Los Angeles; and four grandchildren.

Death-In December 2005, it was announced that Rawls was being treated for lung cancer that metastasized to his brain. He died from this illness on January 6, 2006, at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, California. He is buried at Forest Lawn Memorial Park (Hollywood Hills).

Lou Rawls's final television performance occurred during the 2005-2006 edition of the telethon, honoring Stevie Wonder in September 2005, months before entering the hospital and after having been diagnosed with cancer earlier in the year. He performed "You Are the Sunshine of My Life" and "It Was A Very Good Year" as a tribute to Frank Sinatra.

Awards and honors-On the night of September 29, 1977, Rawls performed the national anthem of the United States before the Earnie Shavers-Muhammad Ali title fight at Madison Square Garden. He was invited to sing the anthem many times over the next 28 years. His final performance was in his hometown of Chicago when he was asked to sing the national anthem before the second game of the 2005 World Series between the Chicago White Sox and Houston Astros at U.S. Cellular Field.

Rawls won the AMA for Favorite Soul/R&B Male Artist in 1979, tied with singer Teddy Pendergrass.

In 1982, Rawls received a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. On January 19, 1985, he sang "Wind Beneath My Wings" at the nationally televised 50th Presidential Inaugural Gala the day before the second inauguration of Ronald Reagan.

In 2021, Rawls was posthumously inducted into the Rhythm & Blues Hall of Fame inductees.

- you. Add 3 tablespoons of the filling to the bottom third of the wrapper.
3. Take the bottom of the wrapper and roll it over the filling. Push in the sides of the wrapper.
4. Dip a fingertip into water and moisten the edges of the exposed wrapper. Bring the outside points of the wrapper towards the center and press the edges together to seal.
5. Continue to roll the egg roll tightly to secure. Place the rolled egg roll onto a sheet tray and repeat with the remaining wrappers and filling.

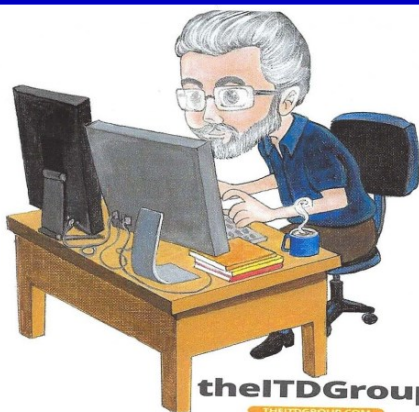

2. In a microwave-safe bowl, melt stick of butter in the microwave. Pour melted butter into prepared baking dish.
3. In a medium bowl, mix together the flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.
4. Pour in the buttermilk. Stir until a sticky batter forms. If batter still seems too dry

add a tad bit more buttermilk until the batter is thick and sticky.

5. Pour biscuit dough into baking dish (right on top of the melted butter.) Some of the butter will run over the top of the dough. **Tip: I will spray my hand with some non-stick spray to help spread the dough out evenly in the pan.**
6. Cut the dough into 9 squares (as best you can). This will help with cutting later when the biscuits are baked.
7. Bake (on the middle oven rack) for about 25-30 minutes, rotating dish once during baking.
8. Oven times **DO VARY** since different ovens have different hot spots, but basically biscuits should be golden brown on top and spring back to the touch. Insert a toothpick into the center. If it comes out clean with no batter, they are done!

Notes

If using unsalted butter, be sure to add 1 teaspoon of salt.

Eat within two days. Make sure to cover leftovers. If stored in the refrigerator, they will last for a week. These biscuits can also be frozen.

Wrap well in freezer-safe plastic wrap and then store in a freezer-safe bag or container. Will freeze for up to 3 months.

Hot Crispy Apple Pies, a dessert pastry just like the ones you get at a drive-through fast food restaurant, only better. And the best part of the "better" is the recipe calls for only two ingredients, yes, only two!

prep time: 20 MINS

cook time: 30 MINS total time: 50 mins

INGREDIENTS:

12 wonton wrappers (found in the produce aisle)

3 cups diced apple fruit filling

1/4 cup water (for sealing the wrappers)

3 cups Crisco shortening (for frying)

A deep fry thermometer is recommended

1. Work with wonton wrappers one at a time. Put a wonton wrapper on a work surface. Place 1/4 cup of fruit filling in the center of

the wonton wrapper in a line not touching the outer edge.

2. Gently fold a small portion of opposite sides to the center, just covering the fruit filling. (Refer to photo above) Then take one end of the wrapper, fold over all the fruit filling, and gently roll it to the other side. The pie should be in a rectangle.
3. Place the pie on a cookie sheet and continue folding the remaining dough around the apple fruit filling.
4. When complete, place the sheet pan in the refrigerator. At this point, you can keep the pies in the refrigerator for up to 12 hours or overnight. It is recommended to freeze after 12 hours. After pies are frozen, place them in a freezer bag for up to 3 months and fry them later. It is not necessary to thaw before frying.
5. At the time of frying, preheat the oven to 200 degrees and set a rack in a baking sheet pan; set aside.
6. Heat enough shortening to reach 3 inches in a heavy gauge skillet or dutch oven. Set the skillet over medium-high heat and bring the shortening to 350 degrees F.
7. Once the temperature reaches 350 degrees F, begin to place 3 to 4 pies in the hot shortening at a time. Turn them over halfway through to keep them from changing their shape and getting heavy on one side.
8. Fry them until they start floating and are golden brown. May have to turn them once more to get an even browning. It will take 3 or 4 minutes. For the frozen ones, it will take 6 minutes or so. Remove them to the prepared rack and dust them with cinnamon sugar. Keep them in the warm oven.
9. Bring the hot shortening back up to 350 degrees before starting to fry the next batch. Remember to let them cool slightly before eating

largely African-American crowd in Indianapolis that Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. had been assassinated. In an emotional speech, Kennedy eulogized the civil rights leader, called for an end to violence and social injustice, and addressed, for the first time in public, the assassination of his brother, President John F. Kennedy, five years earlier. According to some historians, it was one of the greatest speeches ever delivered. Just two months later, Robert Kennedy himself was assassinated during a celebration following his victory in the California primary.

2. Answer: Jacob Marley is a fictional character who appears in the 1843 novella *A Christmas Carol* by Charles Dickens. fate. It is Marley who arranges for the three spirits to visit Scrooge and gives him his opportunity for redemption.

3. Answer: Shaggy is, of course, the lovably goofy human best friend of Scooby-Doo. He is known for his cowardly nature, his goofy sense of humor, and his unwavering loyalty to his friends. But the iconic, food-loving character's well-known moniker is actually just a nickname. In an early episode, it was revealed that his real name is Norville Rogers. The name was inspired by Oliver Norvell Hardy, one half of the comedy duo Laurel and Hardy. Casey Kasem voiced Shaggy for a time when he was portrayed as a vegetarian, at the request of Kasem, who was a vegan.

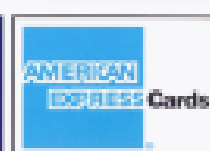

attempt to force a merger between the two leagues, the USFL, led by Donald Trump, filed an antitrust lawsuit against the NFL. Trump's actions are widely viewed as a major factor in the collapse of the USFL shortly thereafter.

5. Answer: According to the Guinness Book of World Records, the 1982 film Gandhi has the most extras in a single scene. The scene depicted Gandhi's funeral, where approximately 300,000 extras were present. To feature the large crowd, the producers hired about 100,000 extras and paid them a fee equivalent to 40 pence each. To make the crowd even bigger, they recruited an additional 200,000 un-

paid volunteers. The scene was shot on January 31, 1981, the 33rd anniversary of Gandhi's funeral. The edited funeral scene lasted only 125 seconds.

6. Answer: Santa Claus has a team of nine reindeer pulling his sleigh on Christmas Eve. Their fabled names are Dasher, Dancer, Prancer, Vixen, Comet, Cupid, Donner, Blitzen, and Rudolph, who leads them all with his bright, red nose. The names of Santa's first eight reindeer were revealed in Clement Clarke Moore's 1823 poem "A Visit from Saint Nicholas," which is perhaps more commonly known as "Twas the Night Before Christmas." Rudolph did not join the pack until 1939, when Robert L. May created him as a marketing ploy for Montgomery Ward.
7. Answer: The Breakfast Club is a 1985 teen coming-of-age cfilm written, produced, and directed by John Hughes. The film stars Anthony Michael Hall, Emilio Estevez, Ally Sheedy, Molly Ringwald, and Judd Nelson and tells the story of five teenagers from different high school cliques who serve a Saturday detention together. The five characters are described respectively as "a brain, an athlete, a basket case, a princess, and a criminal." The media subsequently referred to the film's five main actors as members of a group called the "Brat Pack".
8. Answer: The Grinch had nothing on the 17th-century Puritans, who actually banned the celebration of Christmas in Boston for an entire generation. That's right – from 1659 until 1681, it was illegal to observe Christmas in Boston. The ban on Christmas was a reflection of the religious climate in Boston during the time. The Puritans had a strict interpretation of the Bible, and noted that there was no scriptural basis for commemorating Christmas. By the mid-1700s, the Puritanical views of the holiday had begun to weaken, and the ban was finally revoked in 1681.
