New work requirements are around the corner for able-bodied adults for SNAP and Medicaid. This will translate into 80 hours per month requirement. Work can include volunteer hours. Any organization such as non-profits, religious or government body can track these hours for individuals. If your organization has volunteers, now would be a good time to create a tracking form to be ready for the changes and to help your volunteers meet the new requirements.
