Food Insecurity

The general food insecurity rate in Baker County is 13.2% and 20.3% for children. We have 3,777 SNAP recipients with 6,071 eligible. If the Federal Government cannot end the shutdown SNAP benefits may have no funds after 10/31/25. This Baker Bite will focus on food resources in Baker City. New guidelines for SNAP also go into effect on November 1st, 2025 and some participants will see a reduction in benefits or loss of benefits within 3 months even if the government reopens.

WIC

If you are a woman and an Oregon resident that is pregnant, postpartum, breastfeeding or has a child less than 5 years old and have a household income less than 185% of federal poverty level you may qualify for WIC. For a 2 person household in 2025 the income currently is \$37,814 per year, it raises about \$10,000 per additional family member. Call 541-523-8211 for an appointment. The Health Department hopes funds will last through November.

The Baker City Backpack Program

The Baker City Backpack Program, established in 2010, provides bags of non-perishable food to students in the Baker 5J School District who are at risk and in need. The program aims to ensure these children have access to food when school meal programs are unavailable on weekends. The QR code takes you to the registration page. Your child will receive a bag the week following registration.



The Backpack program has a Surf and Turf Fundraiser on 11/8 at 5 pm at Quail Ridge Golf Course. You can purchase tickets at <https://bakercitybackpack.org/> or make a donation cash to the program. Last week 257 students received bags.

Sharing Pantries

Sharing pantries are small cabinets located around town stocked by local people and organizations. If you need food take some. If you can donate food please donate non-perishable items by placing them in a pantry. The **Baker Rotary Club** attempts to place items weekly in several pantries. The **Baker County Democrats** have pledged to restock at least 1 pantry in town each week starting the 1st week in November until the government shutdown has ended and SNAP benefits resume. They will rotate pantries around town to benefit different neighborhoods. This newsletter would like to see more groups pledge to stock a pantry.
