TLT? What is this?

Transient Lodging Tax. Also called a transient room tax. It is a tax collected from visitors who stay overnight in hotels, BnB's, vacation rentals, etc.... The money comes from people coming to stay in Baker County. The money collected goes into a fund administered by the Transient Lodging Tax Committee. Requests for funds are voted on by the committee and then sent to the Baker County Commission for approval, denial, or further work. These funds can be used for tourism related projects in Baker County. Approximately 80% of the funds are collected from Baker City. Recently \$300,000 was approved for the golf course irrigation project. The golf course holds multiple tournaments annually, which bring a lot of players from out of town, supporting our hotels and restaurants. The bathroom project at Geiser Pollman Park was approved to update the bathrooms. The park holds several events that bring visitors from out of town including Miners Jubilee and Big Foot Festival.
