Dear Shores Family,

Because of the extreme Winter temperatures, please be advised that when turning the water back on after winterizing your condo, you should turn the water back on slowly to avoid any bursting pipes, as rapidly turning on the water can cause a sudden pressure change that could potentially rupture frozen pipes that have partially thawed, especially if they are already weakened by ice expansion. By turning the water on gradually, you allow the ice to melt more evenly, minimizing the risk of damage.

Please remember to follow winterizing procedures if you are not using the condo.
