Our Student-Athlete Program has been at the very core of the development of the Rainbow Way and our commitment to expanding on this will see more young people afforded the opportunity to broaden their horizons.

A series of bespoke courses will be given to all young aspiring footballers within the Rainbow Sport world, ensuring that they are prepared for life. Community:

Rainbow Sport is developing and empowering communities throughout Africa. In a full 'turn-key' solution, Rainbow Sport offers an accessible and high impact solution through the "Me In Team" Platform. This Project in partnership with a local school and a Professional Player supports the provision and maintenance of:

- A classroom

- Community empowered management team to ensure sustainability of the pitch
- Kits and balls

Infrastructure:

The Africa Rainbow Centres (ARC) will be standardised world class centres of sporting excellence dotted across the continent providing best-practice qualitative performance and education spaces for the improvement of access to professional training on the continent. A potential 5 regional hubs would provide employment for many, but most importantly establish a reference points for anchored participation in research and development as never before established on the continent.





Through its Infrastructure Maintenance Fund, Rainbow Sports, will partner with youth clubs and local federations on the continent to develop a broad reaching infrastructure-tied platform to support the sustainable management of infrastructural deficit across Africa.

The fund will allow Rainbow Sports to offer more than just a pathway for the most talented players in Africa to make it through to the professional global game. It will provide identifiable venues and resource centres for more young people and through this give Rainbow Sports more physical branded locations across the continent, a demonstrable commitment to developing the game in Africa.
