## How to Apply

---

### Application Fee

- \$25 per application.
- Your fee covers up to 3 pieces. You do not pay more to submit additional works up to that limit.
- After you submit the form, you will be directed to a PayPal link to pay the \$25 fee. Your application is not complete until payment is received.

### What to Submit

- A completed application form.
- A digital photo of each piece you are submitting. Photos must show the completed, finished work. Each photo file must be under 10 MB. The total size of all files in one submission cannot exceed 15 MB.
- The title, medium, dimensions, and asking price for each piece.

### Where to Submit

Submit your application and photos online at [theartsnet.org](http://theartsnet.org). The form will be live July 13, 2026.

## Eligibility

---

- You must live in Tarrant County, Texas.
- All skill levels are welcome. You do not need to be a professional artist.
- There is no theme for this exhibition. The jury will arrange accepted works by type.

## Art Requirements

---

### Content

- All work must be family-oriented and appropriate for a public library setting.
- Political content is not permitted.
- The jury reserves the right to decline any work it finds unsuitable for the venue.

### Size

- There is no size restriction.
- You must provide the dimensions of each piece on your application. The application is not complete without them.

### Condition

- Work must be original and created by you.
- All 2D work must be ready to hang (wire or sawtooth hanger on the back).
- Work must be in clean, finished condition. No damaged frames or visible repairs.

## What Happens Next

---

- A jury of community artists will review all submissions after August 31.
- You will receive a notification of acceptance or non-acceptance.
- Accepted artists must deliver their work in person to ArtsNET by September 15, 2026.
- ArtsNET will create a consistent information plaque for each piece, showing your name and a short description.
- The gallery is expected to open around October 1, 2026.

## Sold Work and Gallery Duration

---

- The exhibition runs for approximately 6 months.
- If your work sells during the show, a sold sign will be placed on it. The piece stays up for the duration of the exhibition.
- Pricing is set by the artist. ArtsNET will facilitate contact between buyers and artists.
- A portion of each sale goes to ArtsNET. This supports our work bringing arts programs to communities across North Tarrant County.

## Future Exhibitions

---

ArtsNET plans to run this exhibition on a rotating cycle. Upcoming schedule:

- January 2027: Call for artists opens.
- February 2027: Submissions open.
- March 2027: Gallery opens.

ArtsNET is also exploring additional community locations to display work between cycles.
