

ILC Scholarship FAQ

Who is eligible?

- Active KY HOSA member who have placed 1st-5th in their competitive event at SLC and registered for the same event at ILC. State Officers are not eligible.

Can my 4th or 5th place winner who is attending ILC apply for this scholarship?

- Yes, if they are taking the place of a 1st-3rd qualifier that is not attending ILC.

As an advisor, how do I determine if my student qualifies as “need based”?

- Many things can influence a student’s need for financial help, such as parent income, family difficulties, natural disasters (flooding), and student attitude toward fundraising. Be honest in your appraisal of the student’s situation and level of need.

How many ILC attendees may apply?

- Limited to 3 applicants per school, more than 3 applicants per school will result in all applicants from the school being disqualified.

How much is awarded?

- \$500 individual scholarship.
- Number of scholarships awarded depends on funds available.

Who gets the money?

- Funds are awarded to the student’s local chapter, which will reimburse the student if the student paid the expenses for ILC out of pocket.

When can members apply?

- Deadline can be found in the Registration Application guidelines.

When will the recipients be announced?

- 2 weeks after Scholarship deadline

What do the recipients have to do in order to receive the funds?

- Attend ILC, participate in their registered event, and fulfill any other obligations as outlined in the scholarship application

When will scholarships be awarded?

- Scholarships will be awarded 2 weeks after the conclusion of ILC

What if the recipient does not meet the requirements at ILC?

- The funds from the scholarship will not be awarded to the chapter

Who decides what applicants will receive the scholarship?

- The KY HOSA Scholarship Committee.
