Kentucky HOSA Bailey Holt Scholarship Application 2026



Kentucky HOSA established the \$1,000.00 Bailey Holt Memorial scholarship in honor of Bailey Holt, 15, who was tragically killed during the Marshall County High School shooting on January 23, 2018. Her family remembers Bailey as a friend to all, who was driven to become a labor and delivery nurse. Kentucky HOSA hopes that the Bailey Holt Memorial Scholarship will honor her memory, and encourage other Kentucky HOSA members to become future healthcare providers. This is a one-time award and is non-renewable.

Applicant Requirements

- The applicant must be a Kentucky HOSA member, either a 12th grader in the secondary division OR a post-secondary/collegiate member, who is planning to attend a college or university the following year.
- The applicant must be planning to continue his or her education in a healthcare field.
- All scholarship materials must be complete and typed or written legibly, with correct grammar.
- All scholarship materials must be entirely written by the person submitting the application. Submissions containing AI-generated content will not be accepted.
- All typed formatting must be Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced, with black text on a white background, and 1 page front-back.
- All materials must be submitted by midnight Feb. 1, 2026, to the link provided through the Conference Management System (CMS) when registering the member(s) for the State Leadership Conference.
- Only one student per chapter per scholarship may apply and the same student may NOT apply for both scholarships. The advisor may only submit one student per scholarship per chapter. <u>All</u> <u>applicants</u> from a school will be disqualified if more than <u>two</u> students submit the same scholarship application.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on the overall application and individual interview scores
- Once selected as a finalist, applicants will receive a Sign-up Genius link to select an interview slot through the email provided in the application
- Recipients will be announced at the Kentucky State Leadership Conference. If awarded a
 scholarship, the applicant must be present to accept the scholarship. If not present, the funds will
 be returned to the Kentucky HOSA scholarship fund.
- Kentucky HOSA state officers are ineligible to submit a scholarship application.
- All required information from the award letter received at the state conference must be submitted in entirety no later than June 1, 2026.
- Any award monies not claimed will be reapplied to the Kentucky HOSA scholarship fund.
- Applicants for the Bailey Holt Memorial Scholarship must be planning on pursuing a Nursing degree.

Required Materials

Essay

- o No more than 2 pages, typed, double-spaced essay that addresses:
 - Your intent to be involved in a nursing career
 - The three reasons you are a HOSA member
 - Three things you have learned from your advisor
 - What you have learned in your health science courses/HOSA to help you choose your nursing career and the reason you chose it
 - Why you feel your particular college choice will help you achieve your goal
 - Your commitment to HOSA to become a future healthcare professional and to help others live healthy, happy lives.

Three Reference letters, printed/typed on official letterhead, providing examples of the following:

- o Letter 1: academic capabilities and achievements
- o Letter 2: leadership
- o Letter 3: job/career awareness

Current Transcript with unweighted GPA

o Official transcript that shows applicant's GPA on a 4.0 scale (unweighted).

Updated Resume

o Includes full name, address, phone number, current school of attendance, work or intern experience (if any), leadership activities/recognitions (organization/event name, year, description), volunteer/community service (organization/event name, year, description), and Academic honors/achievements.

Recent Photo of Applicant

Must be separate from resume and no smaller than a wallet sized photo (2" x 3")
