

Kentucky HOSA Scholarship Application 2021



Applicant Requirements:

- The applicant must be a Kentucky HOSA member who is a senior in high school planning to attend a college or university (in or out of state) OR in the post-secondary/collegiate division.
- The applicant must be planning to continue your education in your healthcare field of choice.
- All materials must be complete and typed or written legibly with correct grammar.
- All materials must be mailed to us by the applicant or their advisor in one envelope by January 31st! (See Contact and Mailing Information below!) Note: As long as the mail date is on or before January 31st, it will be accepted!
- Only one applicant can be submitted per scholarship (Vescio and Bailey Holt) per school. (Maximum of 2 applicants from one school. All applicants will be disqualified if there are more than 2.)
- The applicant must attend the State Leadership Conference to accept their reward!

Material Requirements:

- Letter of Academic Evidence of Student Learning
 - One-page letter from a person who can provide evidence of successful student learning (ex: teacher, guidance counselor, principal, director, or other person with documentation proving that they are in the school system)
 - While this is in a letter format, any example of successful student learning may be used, including GPA, coursework, certifications/licensure exams, capstone projects, reflection on classroom attitude, classroom participation and contribution, and many others!

- Letter of Evidence of Professionalism
 - One-page letter from a person that knows the applicant well (NOT a parent, other family member, or member of the school system) who can provide evidence of the applicant's professionalism.
 - While this is in a letter format, any example of professionalism may be used, including work ethic, team-working skills, leadership experience, internship or shadowing experience, on-the-job experience, integrity, work quality, discipline, responsibility, and many others!

- Personal Statement
 - The applicant must submit a personal statement based on the following topic: "Describe three (3) exemplary qualities gained through your HOSA experience and explain how you plan to use them in college, the community, and your future career."
 - This statement should only be on the front side of one page, typed, and either single- or double-spaced.

- Current Transcript
 - The applicant's transcript can be official or unofficial but must display the student's current GPA on a 4.0 scale (unweighted).

- Updated Resume
 - Include:
 - Full Name
 - Current School of Attendance
 - Current Unweighted GPA
 - What college or university applicant plans on attending (Note: if undecided, indicate your top options)
 - What career the applicant will be pursuing

- Leadership activities and recognitions
- Include club name, year(s) of activity, position held, and description of duties
 - Community Involvement
- Include volunteer organization, year(s) of service, total hours of service, and description of duties
 - Honors achievements and recognitions
 - Recent photo (Note: this can be on the resume or attached separately)
- Format:
 - One page, both sides accepted
 - Times New Roman, 12 pt. Font
 - Single- or Double-Spaced
 - Black and White Ink
