

Kentucky HOSA Scholarship Application 2023



Anne Vescio was a very dedicated and active person in healthcare around Kentucky. She was the regional director of Kentucky's vocational schools at the time of her early passing. She started the four-year nursing degree at ECU, and played a pivotal role in establishing Kentucky HOSA. Her family started the Anne Vescio scholarship to honor her contribution and dedication to health education in Kentucky, and it continues to provide educational financial support to future healthcare providers through donations from the Vescio family and other sources. The amount awarded varies by year and recipient.

Kentucky HOSA established the \$1,000.00 Bailey Holt memorial scholarship in honor of Bailey Holt, 15, who was tragically killed during the Marshall County High School shooting on January 23, 2018. Her family remembers Bailey as a friend to all who was driven to become a labor and delivery nurse. Kentucky HOSA hopes that the Bailey Holt memorial scholarship will honor her memory and encourage other Kentucky HOSA members to become a future healthcare provider.

Applicant Requirements

- The applicant must be a Kentucky HOSA member, either a 12th grader in the secondary division OR a post-secondary/collegiate member, who is planning to attend a college or university the following year.
- The applicant must be planning to continue his or her education in a healthcare field.
- All scholarship materials must be complete and typed or written legibly, with correct grammar.
- All typed formatting must be Times New Roman, 12 pt font, single- or double- spaced and black text on a white background.
- All materials must be submitted by midnight Feb. 1 on Tallo.
- Only one applicant per scholarship (Vescio and Bailey Holt) per school may be submitted. All applicants from a school will be disqualified if more than two students submit scholarship applications.
- Recipients will be announced at the Kentucky State Leadership Conference. If awarded a scholarship, the applicant must be present to accept the scholarship. If not present, the funds will be returned to the Kentucky HOSA scholarship fund.
- Kentucky HOSA state officers are ineligible to submit a scholarship application.
- Scholarships must be claimed by August the following year of scholarship award.
- Any award monies not claimed will be reapplied to the Kentucky HOSA scholarship fund.

<p>Letter of Evidence of Student Learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o One-page letter from a person who can provide evidence of successful student learning (teacher, guidance counselor, etc.). Documentation can include GPA, coursework, certifications/licensure exams, capstone projects, reflection on classroom attitude, classroom participation and contributions. 	<p>Essay</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o 1-2 page, front only, typed, single or double spaced essay that addresses the three reasons you are a HOSA member, three things you have learned from your advisor, what you have learned in your health science courses/HOSA to help you choose your career and the reason you chose it, why you feel your particular college choice will help you achieve your goal, and your commitment to HOSA to become a future healthcare professional and to help others live healthy, happy lives.
<p>Letter of Evidence of Professionalism</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o One-page letter from a person (a non-relative and not a member of the school system) that knows the applicant well and can provide evidence of the applicant’s professionalism. Documentation can include examples of work ethic, team-working skills, leadership experience, internship, job shadowing, on-the-job experience, integrity, work quality, and responsibility. Can be two-sided. 	
<p>Personal Statement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o One-page, front only, typed, single or double-spaced personal statement based on the following topic: “Describe three exemplary qualities gained through your HOSA experience and explain how you plan to use them in college, the community, and your future career.” 	<p>Three Reference letters providing examples of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Letter 1: academic capabilities and achievements o Letter 2: leadership o Letter 3: job/career awareness

<p>Current Transcript with unweighted GPA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Official or unofficial transcript that shows applicant’s GPA on a 4.0 scale (unweighted). 	
<p>Updated Resume</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Includes full name, address, phone number, current school of attendance, work or intern experience (if any), leadership activities/recognitions (organization/event name, year, description), volunteer/community service (organization/event name, year, description), and Academic honors/achievements. 	
<p>Recent Photo of Applicant</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o May be on the resume or attached
