- ▶ For ILC – deadlines changed to May 15 for consistency



HOSA Website and Guidelines

Members of The Team - Lieutenants

- ▶ One to two lieutenants for each category
- ▶ Works one-on-one to assure the EMs have the tools, knowledge, and skills to successfully manage a competitive event
- ▶ Provide support to the EMs
- ▶ Are on site with their events and ensures events are running appropriately and on time
- ▶ Preparation prior to conference includes completing fact sheets and determining list of supply and event personnel needs

Other Members of The Team

Event Managers (EMs)

- ▶ One to two event managers for each event
- ▶ Check in competitors
- ▶ Set up, conduct and direct the actual event
- ▶ Manage the details and the people
- ▶ Ensure the timekeepers, competitors and patients (if applicable) are where they are supposed to be
- ▶ Ensure consistency with competitors
- ▶ Manage the “outside” of the room
- ▶ Assure integrity of all event forms and processes



All of this occurs when you are knowledgeable of the event guidelines!!

Time Commitment for Event Manager

- ▶ Prior to conference
 - ▶ 2-3 hours
 - ▶ Answering emails from Angie or your lieutenant (December – March)
 - ▶ Reviewing guidelines
- ▶ Conference
 - ▶ EM Orientation
 - ▶ Will be done virtually about 2 weeks prior to SLC
 - ▶ Thursday night
 - ▶ Pick up shirt and look at black bag (if necessary)
 - ▶ Thursday evening
 - ▶ There are a few events scheduled
 - ▶ Friday - Event
 - ▶ 2-4 hours depending on event

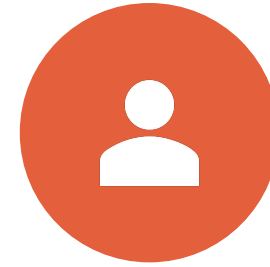
Judges

Things to Remember for SLC

- ▶ Have students pick their event early.
- ▶ When affiliating students, make sure division is correct.
- ▶ Students can only register for one competitive event in categories 1-5, one National Geographic Exam, and/or multiple Recognition Events (Category 6).
 - ▶ Each chapter can only register one student/team per event in categories 1-5 (except for National Geographic Exams and Recognition Events).
- ▶ Students who take an online test only should sign up for Courtesy Corp, Ambassador, Intern, or Voting Delegate.
- ▶ Tallo/Wufoo: These deadlines are important to meet.
 - ▶ ***If the requirements are not uploaded to Tallo/Wufoo, students WILL NOT receive an appointment time.***
- ▶ When registering a team for an event, make sure the correct number of competitors are registered for the team per guidelines and all team members are connected to the same team.
 - ▶ If an event has a range, a good practice is to have the number of team members at the high side of the range in case a team member cannot make it to conference.
- ▶ CE change deadline is FINAL. No "substitutions" after the testing deadline.
- ▶ IDEA Events (special needs) – proper forms must be uploaded to compete.
- ▶ Showcases for MI, HCD, HCP are mandatory.

Things to Remember for SLC

- ▶ There are no orientations, so advisors need to review guidelines for each event with students.
- ▶ Students must bring photo ID.*
 - ▶ It would be a good idea for advisors to go ahead and complete the “form” for each student in case the student forgets to bring to SLC.
- ▶ Make sure competitors bring appropriate supplies as listed on the guidelines.
- ▶ Only competitors will be allowed to ride the bus to offsite events.
- ▶ Appropriate dress
 - ▶ HOSA Hello
 - ▶ Competitive Event – review guidelines
 - ▶ General Session
 - ▶ Closing Session – Awards
 - ▶ NO JEANS or LEGGINGS!
- ▶ Second Round Qualifiers will be in the registration packet.
- ▶ Read emails and meet deadlines.
