#### SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

#### 1. General Information

- All games will be played according to USA Softball.
- Tournament format will be 3GG, single elimination
- All teams must check in at least **30 minutes prior** to their first game.
- Insurance and roster are due October 29th
- Teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled starting time
- OFFICIAL SCORE BOOK: home team is official scorekeeper in all tournament games. BOTH teams MUST report scores (and division you're in) within 30 minutes of games end using both team names to 330-507-0751 and 330-507-2637

## 2. Team & Player Requirements

- Teams must have a minimum of 8 players to start a game.
- Players must appear on the official team roster and may not play for multiple teams in the same tournament.
- A team starting with 8 players will record an **automatic out** in the 9th batting position.

### 3. Game Length & Timing

- games are 70 minutes finish the inning
- Pool play games can end in a tie.
- Elimination games tied after 7 innings or time limit will use the **International Tiebreaker Rule** (last completed batter starts at 2nd base).

## Run Rule (Mercy Rule):

- 12 runs after 3 innings
- 10 runs after 4 innings
- 8 runs after 5 innings.

# 4. Batting Rules

- Teams may bat 9 players, the entire roster, or use a DP/Flex option (per USA Softball rules).
- If batting the lineup, free defensive substitutions are allowed.
- Courtesy runners allowed for pitcher and catcher at any time (must be the last batted out).

### 5. Base Running

- Courtesy runners allowed for injured players (must be last recorded out).
- malicious contact will result in ejection.
- Sliding is encouraged on close plays at the plate.

### 6. Sportsmanship & Conduct

- **Zero tolerance** for fighting, abusive language, or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Ejection = removal from the game and possible suspension from the tournament.
- Only the Head Coach may talk to the umpire regarding calls.

## 7. Umpires & Protests

- Umpires' calls are final.
- Protests must be made **before the next pitch** and must involve rule interpretation, not judgment calls.
- The tournament director will review any formal protest.
- Championship games plan to have 2 umpires (may be altered due to availability)

### 8. Weather & Schedule

• Games may be delayed or shortened due to weather.

# 9. Refund policy

- no games played receive 75% refund, one game played receive 50% refund, 2 or more games played, no refund is given.
- A game is considered official after **3 innings**.
- Tournament director reserves the right to modify rules or schedule for time/weather.

#### 10. Awards & Bracket

- Top 2 teams in each division will receive trophies or medals.
- Bracket placement determined by:
- 1. Win-loss record
- 2. Head-to-head
- 3. Run differential
- 4. Coin toss (if necessary).
