

The Westcountry Aerial and Pole Tournament is available to anyone wishing to perform from a piece of equipment which can be rigged from a single rigging point.

Rigging point is 5m high. There is a large floor space all around the rigging point to allow for floor work.

2 Poles available, 4m high, spin or static.

Floor is a firm dance, stage floor (suitable for heels)

Crash mats are compulsory for all youth - junior competitors and will be supplied for anyone wanting them. No marks will be lost for using crash mats.

No Aerial equipment will be supplied on the day, we prefer each studio to bring their own.

The rigging points are adjustable height with a swivel.

Please bring your own strops and carabina to clip straight into our swivel.

PLEASE ATTACH A LUGGAGE LABEL TO YOUR EQUIPMENT WITH THE NAMES OF ALL PERFORMERS PERMITTED TO USE IT.

There will be 2 Poles side by side which can either be static or spinny.

Aerial Allsorts and South West Aerial Championship accepts no responsibility for equipment failure and requests you have any equipment safety checked before use.

All equipment can be rigged at adjustable height.

Any equipment that can be rigged from above can be entered into the Aerial Competition. For example Flying Pole will be in the Aerial Comp and not the Pole Comp.
