Pole Competition

Early entry open to studios from Devon, Cornwall, Somerset, Dorset, Gloucester, Wiltshire and Hampshire. Then remaining spaces opened up to the rest of the country. Please check with us before submitting your entry fee to ensure there is still space.

Entry fee is £200 per studio and non refundable.

If you wish to enter both the pole and aerial competition its £350 for both.

10 Studio places available.

Each studio should have **one person in each** of the following categories to represent them :

Aged 13 and Under

Aged 14 - 17

Instructor

Doubles

Adult Beginner

Adult Intermediate

Adult Advanced

Group

Participants may only perform in one category plus the Group Routine.

Age as of 18th Sept 2022

Doubles and Group routine maybe any age or combination of ages.

Doubles maybe instructors or amateurs. 2 poles side by side, static or spin will be available if required and you may select any equipment.

Group Routine may contain instructors but there must be a higher number of amateurs in the group than instructors. You can select the number of participants in the Group Routine. 2 poles side by side, static or spin will be available for the Group Routine.

All routines should be no longer than 3min 30sec

Group routine no longer than 5min.

Music : No offence language, do not go over the time limit. Marks will be deducted for breaking time limit.

You must have someone represent you in **at least 6 out of the 8 categories**. If you choose to not participant in one category an average of your other scores will be used.

Entrants may not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Entrants must be fit and able to take part and responsible for their own warm up.

The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone acting unprofessionally.

We reserve the right to use any photos or videos taken at the final for marketing purposes.

Props are permitted but please notify us so we can accommodate stage set up and removal. They must be easy and quick to take onto and remove from the stage, no mess.

Music must be sent to the organisers via email 21 days before final date in MP3 format. Please also bring a back up on the day in case of tech difficulties.

Costumes must be appropriate and safe to perform in. No nudity. No Heels in Youths.

Marks will be deducted if any rules are broken.

We encourage all competitors to use crash mats and will except no responsibility for those who choose not to. All competitors compete at their own risk. Please only perform moves your competent in and your instructor has approved.

Restrictions on moves.

No restrictions on Youth, Double, Adult Advanced, Instructor or Group Routine.

Marks will be deducted for illegal moves.

As a general rule please refer to The Spincity Pole Bible as a guide.

Beginner Adults

Only a basic invert from the floor is allowed, no moves from the invert.

Spins from the floor.

Handstands and headstands from the floor.

Basic seats.

No up side down moves.

Intermediate Adult

No arms only moves allowed
