

Equipment Guide

Rigging point for solo routines is 5.5m high. There is a large floor space all around the rigging point to allow for floor work.

For our doubles 2 rigging points side by side can be used to allow for synchronised moves. 4m apart. 5m high, or can use 1 point as above.

For the Group Routine 3 points can be used, centre at 5.5m high, one either side at 5m.

2 Poles available, 4m high, spin or static.

Floor is soft rubber jigsaw matting.

Crash mats are compulsory for all competitors and will be supplied for anyone wanting them. No marks will be lost for using crash mats.

The only equipment supplied on the day will be a Silk, Sling, 95cm Tableless Hoop, various length strops and swivels. If you require anything other this please bring with you.

2 Poles provided side by side for pole competition.

Please feel free to bring your own equipment if required. Aerial Allsorts and South West Aerial Championship accepts no responsibility for equipment failure and requests you have any equipment safety checked before use. Please also bring your own strop and carabina for quick changeovers.

All equipment can be rigged at adjustable height.

Any equipment that can be rigged from above can be entered into the open category. .
For example Flying Pole will be in the Aerial Comp and not the Pole Comp.
