Flights & Transfers

- Book flights to arrive at least one day before embarkation to account for delays
- Call The Hotel When You Arrive At The Airport For “Free Pick Up”. Once You Check In, Purchase Your Transfer For Transportation To The Port The Next Morning.
- * Inquire another mode of transportation for the group upon return.
- Keep all of Your confirmation numbers accessible:
Flight, Hotel, Transfers, Cruise Reservation.

Hotel Accommodations

- Pre-cruise hotel near the port recommended (especially for morning embarkations)
- Verify hotel shuttle service to cruise terminal or arrange transportation
- Confirm check-in/check-out times align with cruise schedule

Cruise Gratuities

- Royal Caribbean auto-charges daily gratuities to your stateroom account (\$16-18.50 per person/day depending on cabin category as of 2026)
- Pre-paid gratuities can be added during booking or before sailing
- Additional cash tips for exceptional service are optional

LUGGAGE & IDENTIFICATION

****Special Luggage Tags****

- Royal Caribbean provides official cruise tags (available online or at terminal)
- Print and attach tags securely to all checked luggage before arriving at port
- Include name, ship name, sailing date, stateroom number, and emergency contact
- Use bright or distinctive luggage identifiers for easy spotting



Sole Purpose Travellers

Carry-On Essentials

- Medications in original prescription bottles (REQUIRED)
- Passport or approved government ID
- Cruise documents and SetSail pass
- Credit card for onboard account setup
- Swimsuit (pools open embarkation day)
- Change of clothes in case luggage is delayed
- Essential toiletries and valuables
- Phone chargers

WHAT NOT TO BRING ON THE SHIP

Prohibited Items:

- Weapons of any kind (including pocket knives, scissors over 4 inches)
- Illegal drugs and CBD products
- Candles, incense, coffee makers, hot plates, irons, steamers
- Extension cords without surge protectors
- Alcoholic beverages (except one 750ml bottle of wine per adult in carry-on only)
- Beer and hard liquor (Confiscated and not returned)
- Drones
- Hoverboards and self-balancing scooters
- Pepper spray or mace

Allowed with Restrictions:

- ONE 12-pack of standard cans/cartons (12 oz) of soda or water per stateroom (must be in carry-on, not checked luggage)
- One 750ml bottle of wine per guest 21+ (carry-on only; \$15 corkage fee if consumed in dining rooms)
- Power strips WITH surge protectors (no extension cords)
- Hair dryers, curling irons, straighteners

PORT EXCURSIONS & ISLAND VISITS

****What NOT to Bring to Ports:****

- Illegal substances (severe penalties in foreign countries)
- Large amounts of cash (use credit cards where possible)
- Excessive valuables or expensive jewelry

- Weapons or items that could be considered weapons

Prohibited agricultural items (fruits, plants, vegetables, meats)

Port Day Essentials to Bring:

Ship ID card (SetSail pass) - REQUIRED for re-boarding

- Valid passport (required even for "closed-loop" Caribbean cruises when visiting foreign ports)
- Small amount of local currency or USD

Sunscreen, hat, and sun protection

- Refillable water bottle

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PLEASE BE ADVISED.....

THE SHIP WILL LEAVE WITHOUT YOU IF YOU ARE LATE

- You are responsibility to return to the ship on time (even if you are on ship-sponsored excursions)

Ship time is the official time (may differ from local island time)

MEDICAL & HEALTH ESSENTIALS

Emergency Medical Kit:

Prescription medications (7-10 day supply minimum in original bottles)

- Over-the-counter: motion sickness medication, pain relievers, anti-diarrheal, antacids
- Bandages, antiseptic wipes, antibiotic ointment
- Thermometer
- Seasickness remedies (Dramamine, ginger candies, acupressure bands)

Aloe vera (for sunburn)

- Hand sanitizer
- Any medical devices (CPAP, glucose monitors, etc.)

Important Medical Notes:

- Ship has medical facility (fees apply - can be expensive)
- Bring travel insurance with medical evacuation coverage
- List all allergies and medical conditions on cruise health form
- Notify Advisor or cruise line in advance of serious medical conditions or mobility needs

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Make Sure These Items Are In Your Carry-On, Not Your Checked Suitcase At The Port

- Valid passport (required for Caribbean cruises- , even closed-loop (begins and ends at the same U.S. port)
- cruise documents (boarding pass, luggage tags)

SetSail pass (print or mobile)

- Government-issued photo ID (as backup)
- Credit card for onboard account setup
- Travel insurance documents#
- Emergency contact list
- Copies of prescriptions

Digital Backups Recommended:

- Photos of passport ID page

Cruise confirmation numbers

- Travel insurance policy numbers
- Credit card contact numbers
- Flight confirmations

ROYAL CARIBBEAN SPECIFIC RULES & STANDARDS

- Must be 21+ to consume alcohol (25+ to book a cabin without an adult 25+)

Formal/elegant nights: 1-2 per cruise (check specific sailing)

- Dress code enforced in main dining room (no tank tops, swimwear, shorts at dinner)

Smoking only in designated outdoor areas

- Casino and bars have age restrictions
- Photography restrictions in certain areas

Account & Payments:

- All charges accumulated onboard will go your stateroom account. These charges must be settled at end of cruise to avoid you being detained.being detained.
- Link credit card during online check-in or at embarkation
- Daily spending summary delivered to cabin
- Internet packages and beverage packages must be purchased for entire cruise duration

Safety Requirements:

- Mandatory muster drill (emergency assembly) before departure
- Must attend or participate via stateroom TV
- Life jackets in cabin - do not remove from ship

Environmental Policies:

No throwing items overboard at any time

- Respect marine wildlife

FINAL REMINDER CHECK

- ✓ Complete online check-in 3-5 days before sailing | CHECK IN: JUNE 18TH
- ✓ Download/ Update Royal Caribbean app before departure.
- ✓ Set up SeaPass account and review onboard
- ✓ Purchase beverage or internet packages before sailing (often discounted)
- ✓ Check weather forecast and pack layers
- ✓ Bring power strip with surge protector (no extension cords)
- ✓ Pack formal attire for elegant nights
- ✓ Verify passport expiration (must be valid 6 months beyond)
- ✓ Notify bank/credit card of travel dates
- ✓ Review shore excursion policies and book early if interested
