San Angelo Mayoral Elections Coming Up!

San Angelo, TX's citywide elections are scheduled for Saturday, May 3rd, 2025, offering residents the opportunity to elect a new Mayor, as well as three City Councilmembers, and decide on a significant bond proposal. Here's the information you need to know about what's on your ballot and how you can vote:

What's On The Ballot?

Voters will elect the next Mayor of San Angelo, as well as City Councilmembers for Single-Member Districts 2, 4, and 6. There are currently four candidates slated to run in the mayoral election: Gary Jenkins, Joshua Burleson, Tom Thompson, and Juan Acevedo. As she is termlimited, incumbent Mayor Brenda Gunter will not be running for a third consecutive term. Additionally, a \$41 million bond to renovate the 67-year-old San Angelo Coliseum will be on the ballot, which would necessitate a \$37.60 tax increase per \$100,000 taxed every year.

How Can I Vote?

Election Day will be on May 3rd, 2025, with early voting available from April 22nd to 29th. Voter registration applications are available at the Tom Green County Election/Voter Registration Office, located on the first floor of the Edd B. Keyes Building, or can be obtained online. Completed applications can be returned in person or by mail. Citizens can also register to vote when renewing their driver's license in person at a Texas Department of Public Safety office.
