Results of the Election

The results are in, and Mr. Tom Thompson has been declared the winner of the San Angelo mayoral election! Voter turnout in the 2025 city election increased dramatically compared to the last election: a whopping 11,071 voters showed up to make their voices heard this year, nearly double compared to 6,341 in 2021! That's a huge leap, with the turnout rate jumping from 10.33% to 16.74%. Thank you to the voters of San Angelo who went to the polls on May 3rd for helping make this election even more representative of the people of San Angelo!

How We Made Our Voter Brochure

Bringing our election brochure to life was a difficult task, but our team rose to the challenge! Balancing the project with our high school schedules, we spent weeks sending out questionnaires and coordinating interviews with every candidate in mayoral race. Out of candidates. successfully we interviewed 9 over the course of a month-including the newly elected Mayor Tom Thompson himself!
