Texas Voters Pass All 17 Amendments on Election Day!

On Election Day, November 4th, 2025, Texans voted to pass all 17 State Constitutional Propositions, officially turning them into Amendments to the Texas State Constitution. Almost 3 million Texas voters constituting 16% of the state population took part in this election, which is 500,000 more than the last amendment referendum in 2023!
