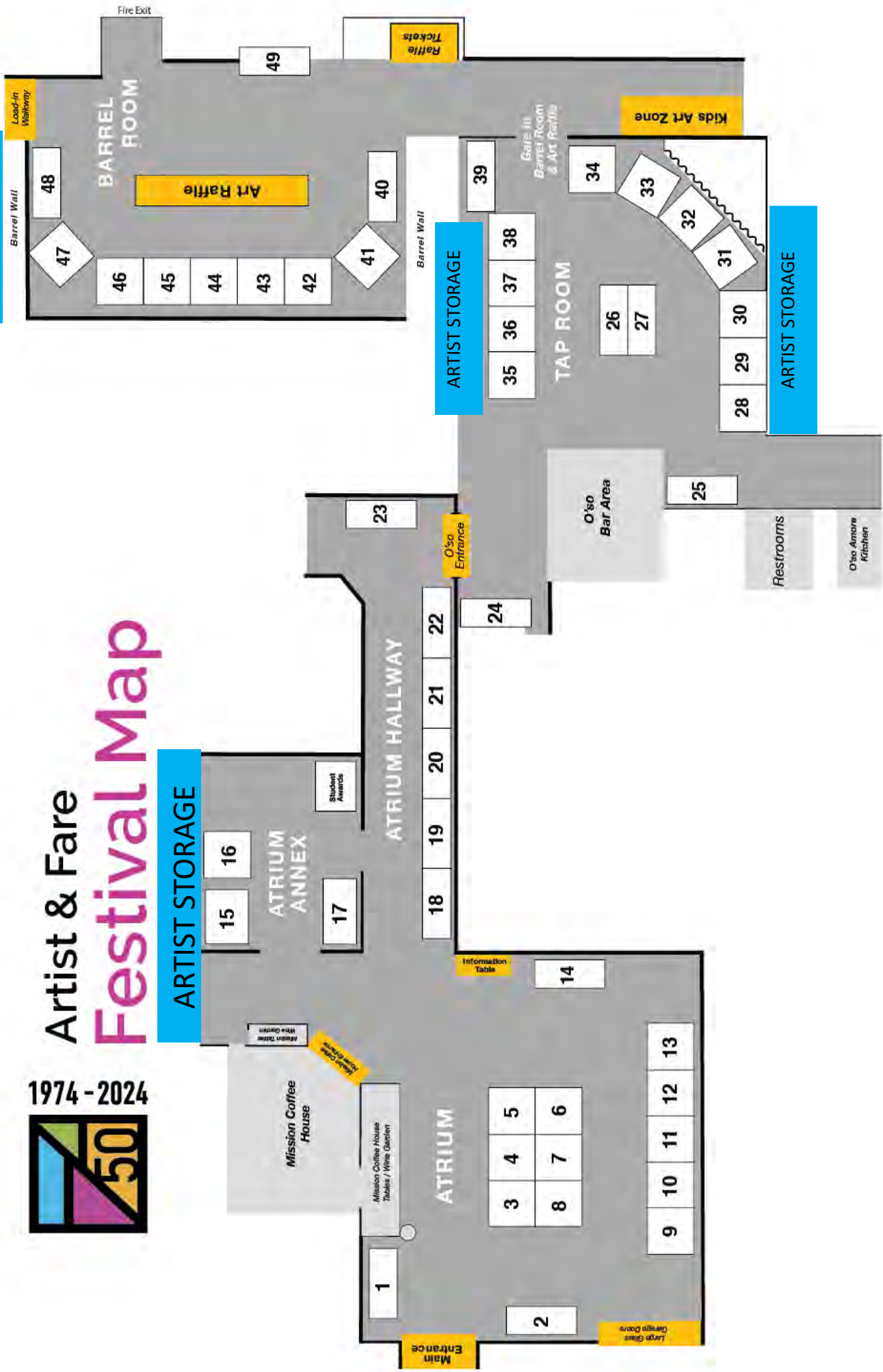

- We do NOT provide any carts for load-in

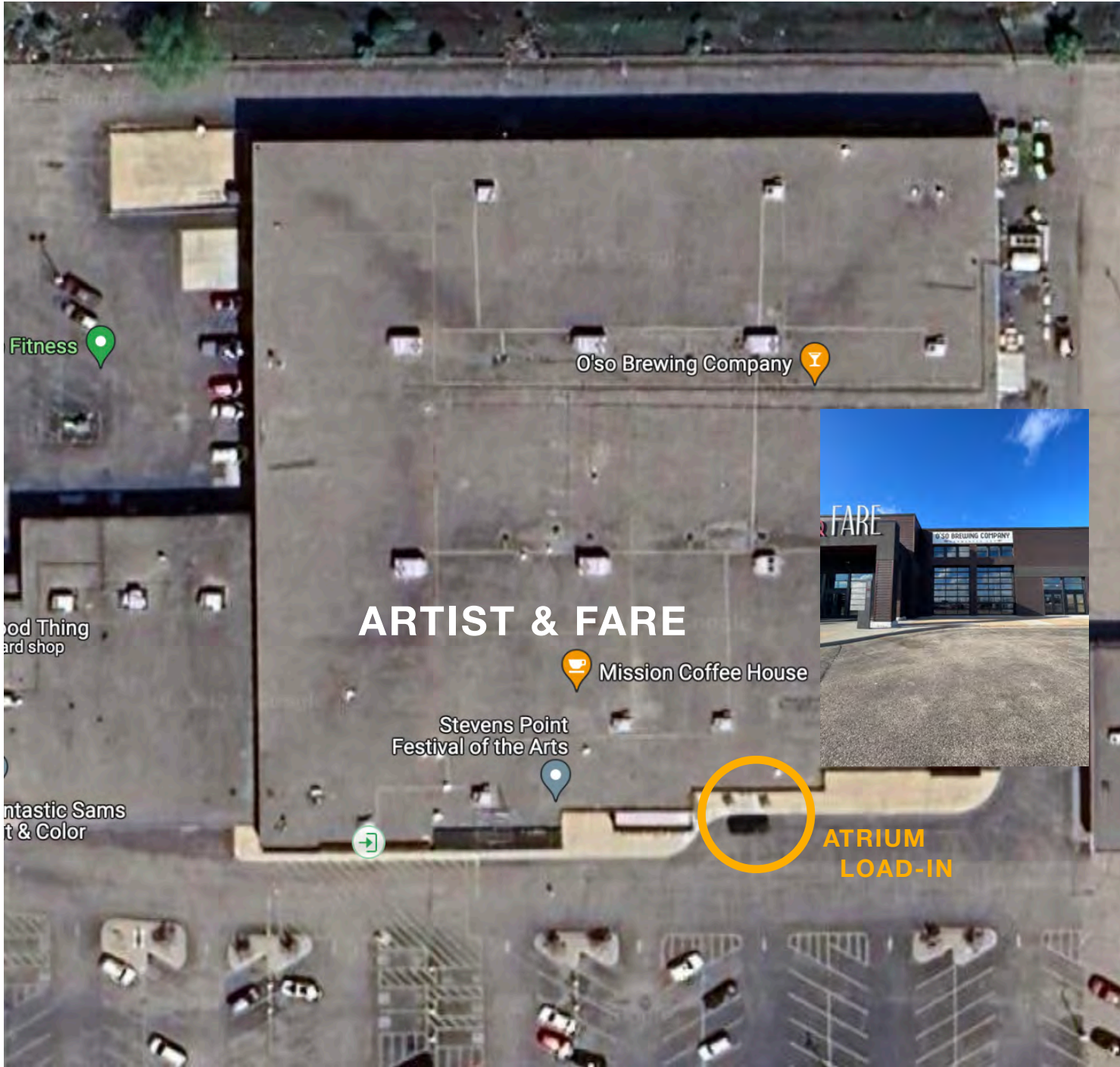
ARTIST STORAGE: Artist storage is behind the annex.

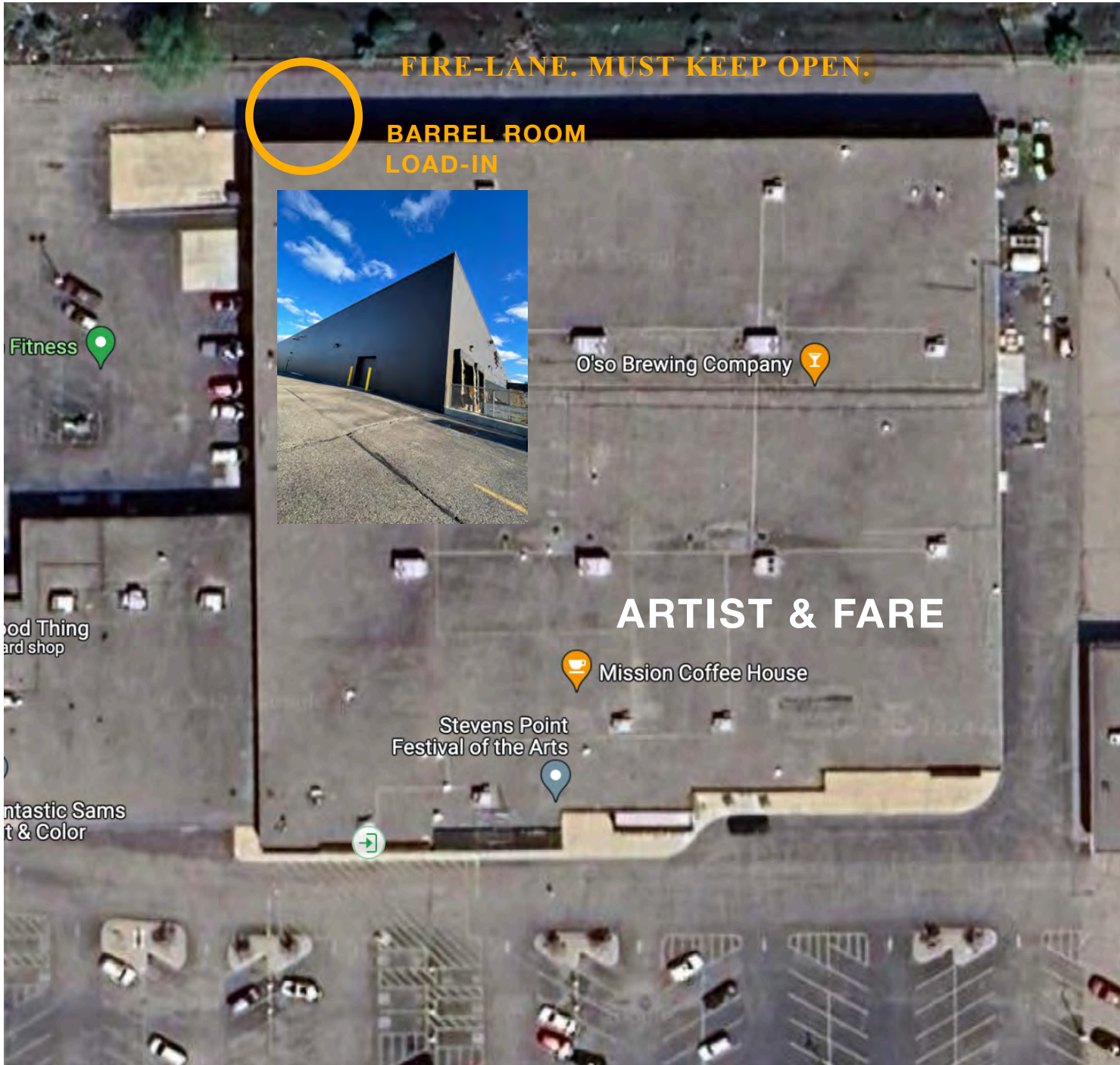
